# 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE


### **Executive Summary**

As of 2003, Floyd County's largest private sector was Manufacturing, representing 21.55 percent (1,254) of the county's total covered employment of 5,820. Most of the employment in this sector was in the Transportation Equipment Manufacturing industry. The county's total employment increased by 0.50 percent since 2002, but the average annual wage increased by 1.48 percent to \$24,971 for all industries.

Floyd County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$480 for 2003. This was an increase of 1.48 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was Wholesale Trade, averaging \$720 with gross total wages of \$7.9 million. The Information sector had the largest percentage decrease in average weekly wage of 11.34 percent (\$76) between 2002 and 2003.



# Reporting Units by Industry in 2003 in Floyd County A Unit is Defined as a Worksite






