
FREMONT 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE

Executive Summary

As of 2003, Fremont County's largest private sector was Manufacturing, representing 40.69 percent (1,400) of the county's total covered employment of 3,441. Over 42 percent of the employment in this sector was in Transportation Equipment Manufacturing. The county's total employment increased by 0.35 percent since 2002 and the average annual wage increased by 3.70 percent to \$28,014 for all industries.

Fremont County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$539 for 2003. This was an increase of 3.65 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was Manufacturing, averaging \$736 with gross total wages of \$53.6 million.




