
IOWA 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE

Executive Summary

As of 2003, Iowa County's largest private sector was Manufacturing, representing 43.52 percent (4,142) of the county's total covered employment of 9,518. Over 56 percent of this sector's employment is in the Electrical Equipment Manufacturing industry. Although the county's total employment decreased by 2.76 percent since 2002, the average annual wage increased by 2.86 percent to \$30,089 for all industries.

Iowa County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$579 for 2003. This was an increase of 2.84 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was Manufacturing, averaging \$802 with gross total wages of \$172.6 million. This sector also had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 7.80 percent (\$58) between 2002 and 2003, and also boasted one of the few sector increases in employment (1.22 percent) in 2003.




