## 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE

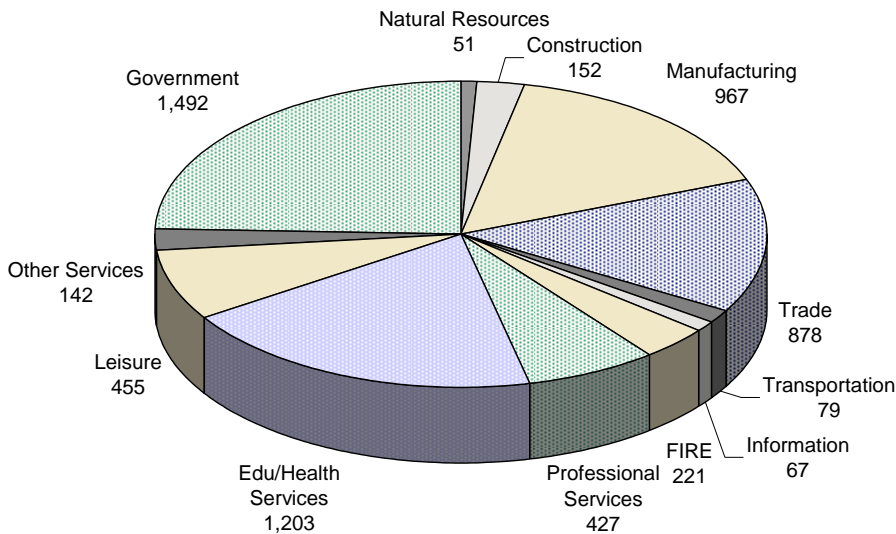
### Executive Summary

As of 2003, Page County's largest private industry was Education & Health Services, representing 19.61 percent (1,203) of the county's total covered employment of 6,134. Although the county's total employment decreased by 2.06 percent since 2002, the average annual wage increased by 2.43 percent to \$24,450 for all industries.

Page County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$470 for 2003. This was an increase of 2.40 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage was in the largest sector, Manufacturing, averaging \$718 with gross total wages of \$36.1 million. This sector also had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 7.49 percent (\$50).

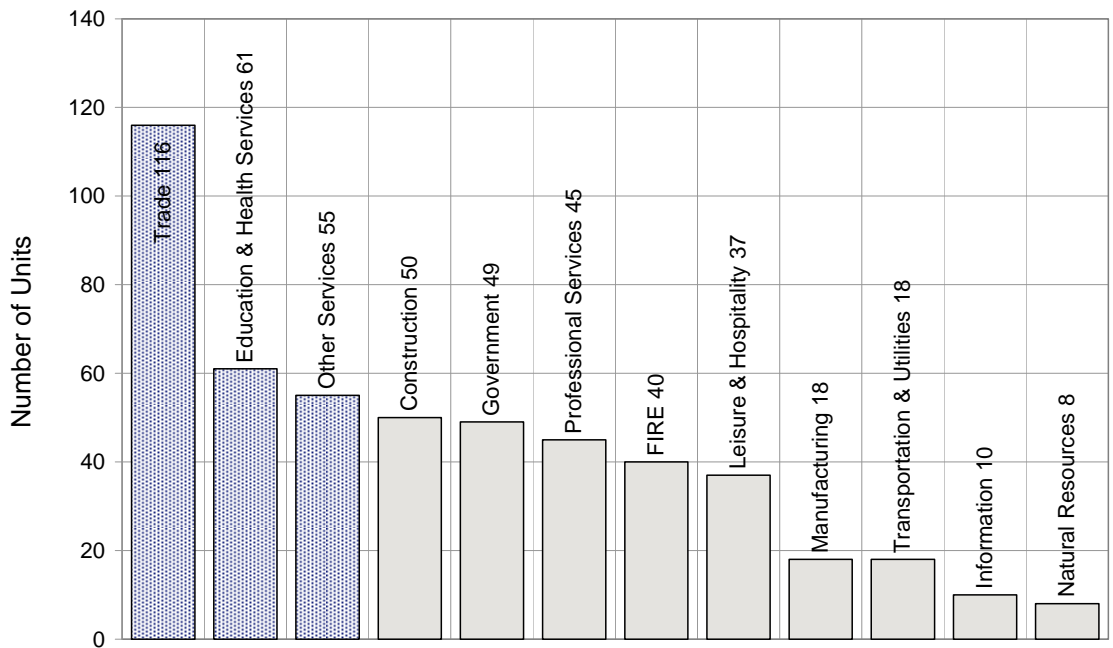

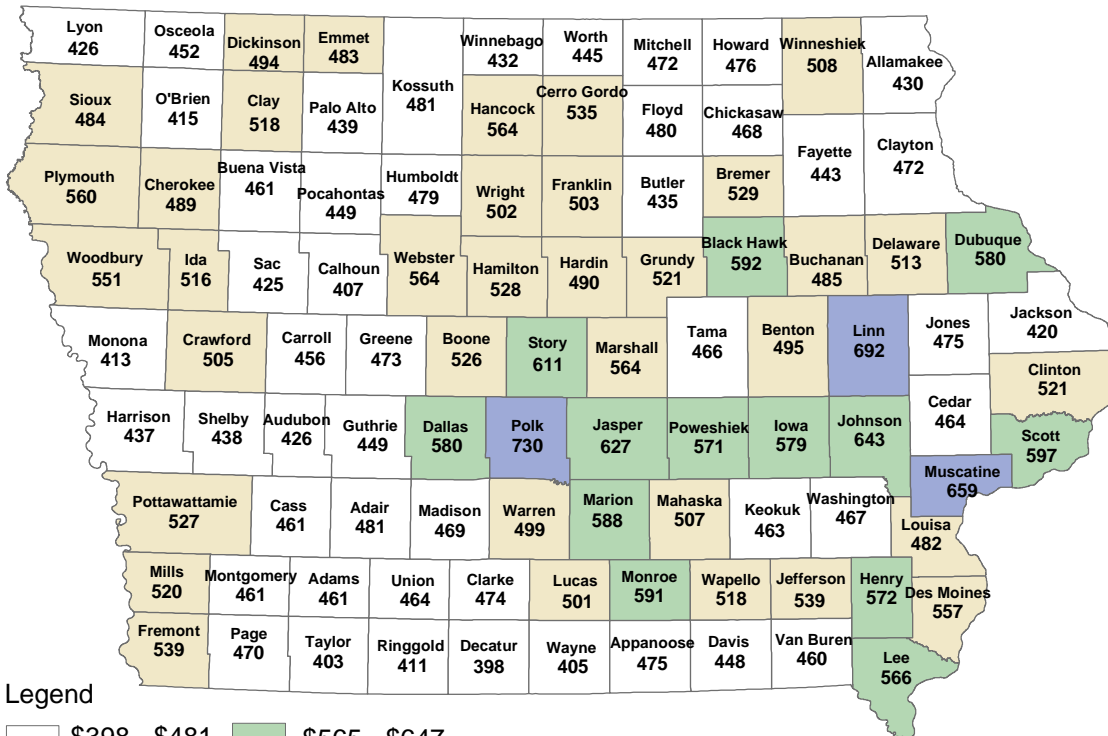

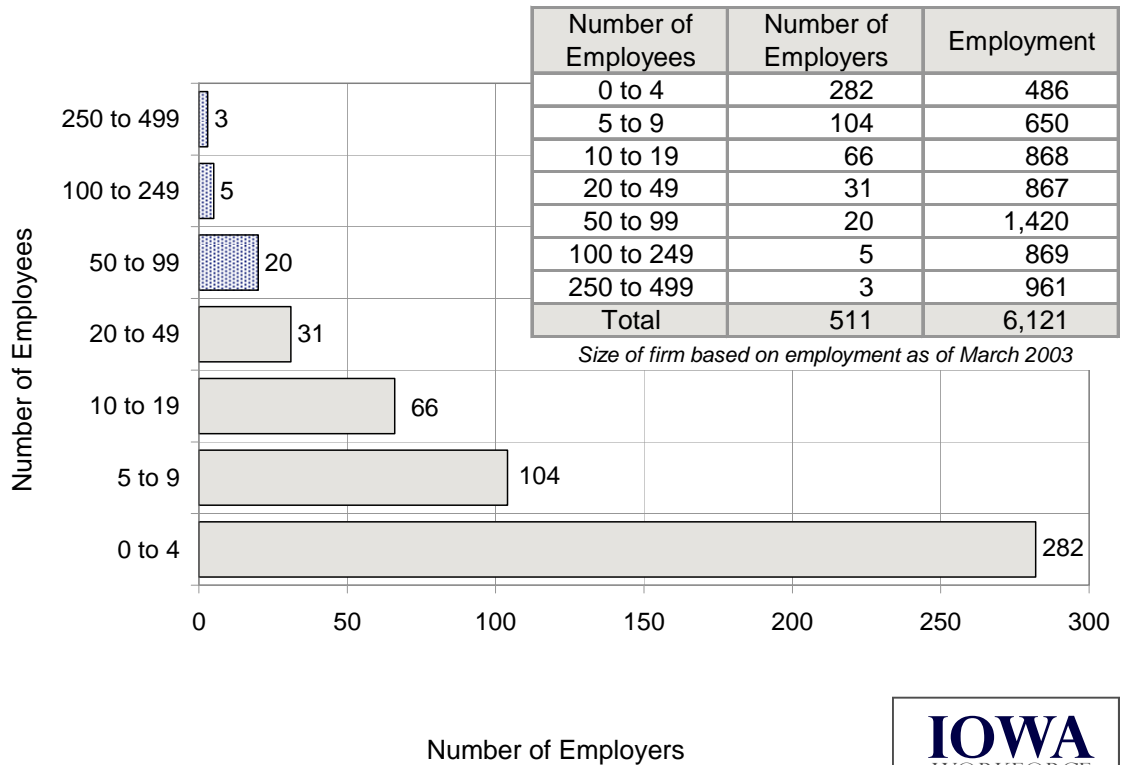
