
# **POTTAWATTAMIE** 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE

## **Executive Summary**

As of 2003, Pottawattamie County's largest private sector was Trade, representing 21.71 percent (7,777) of the county's total covered employment of 35,818. Although the county's total employment decreased by 0.87 percent since 2002, the average annual wage increased by 3.52 percent to \$27,423 for all industries. More than 55 percent of employment in Government consists of public education.

Pottawattamie County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$527 for 2003. This was an increase of 3.54 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was Transportation & Utilities, averaging \$759 with gross total wages of \$47.3 million.




