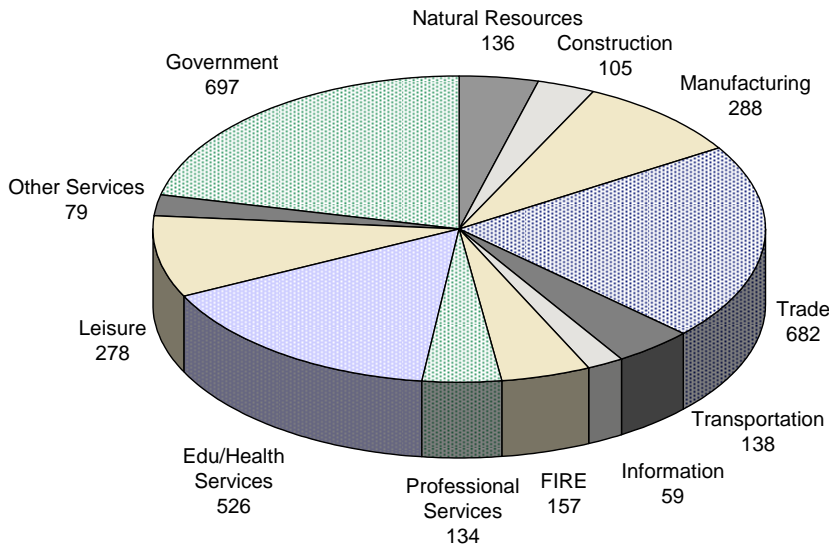
Executive Summary

As of 2003, Sac County's largest private sector was Trade, representing 20.81 percent (682) of the county's total covered employment of 3,278. This was followed closely by Education & Health services, which reported 16.05 percent (526). The average annual wage increased by 3.95 percent to \$22,091 for all industries.

Sac County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$425 for 2003. This was an increase of 3.91 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was Wholesale Trade, averaging \$554 with gross total wages of \$6.9 million. The Retail Trade sector had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 9.19 percent (\$34) between 2002 and 2003.

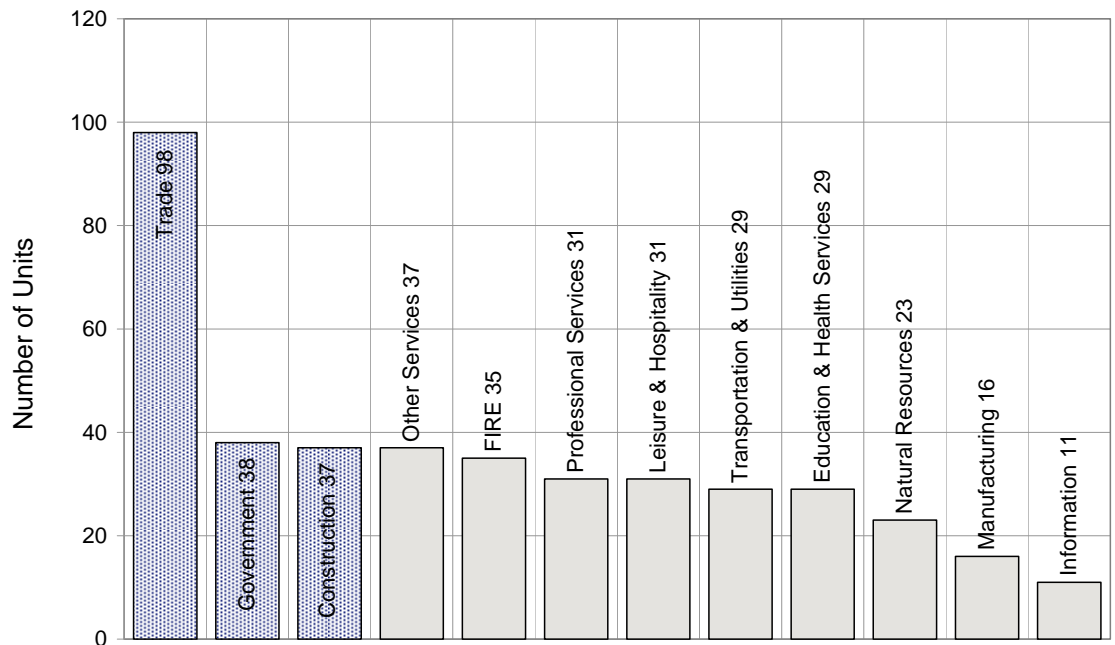

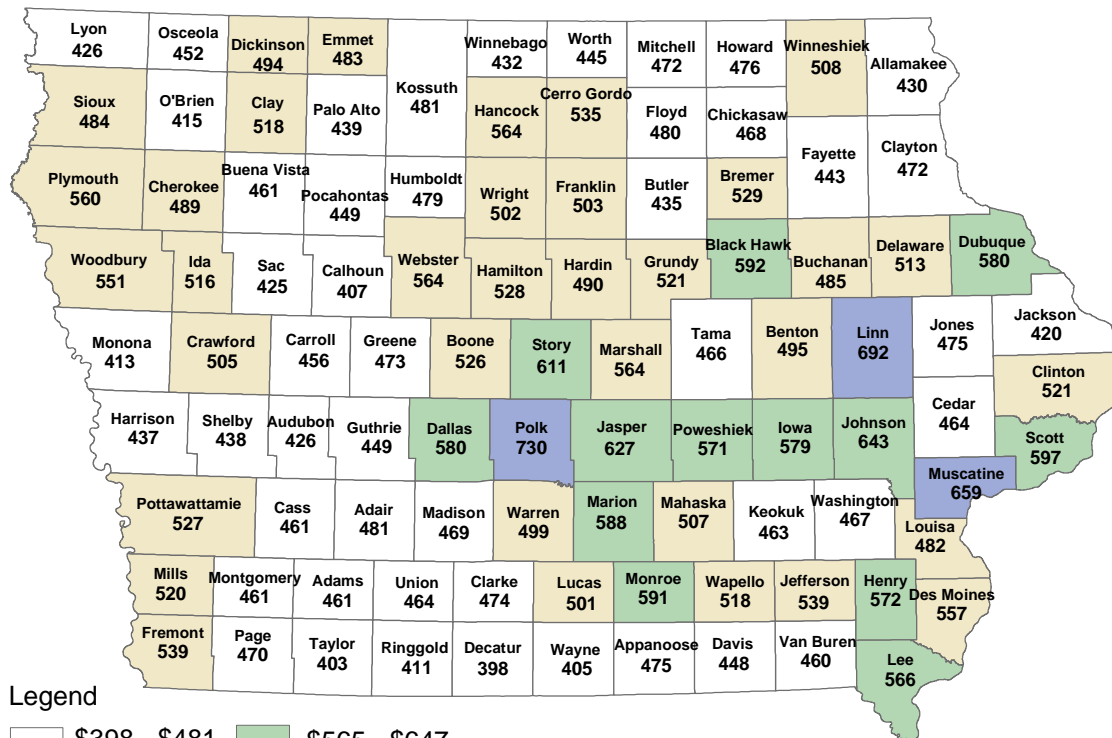

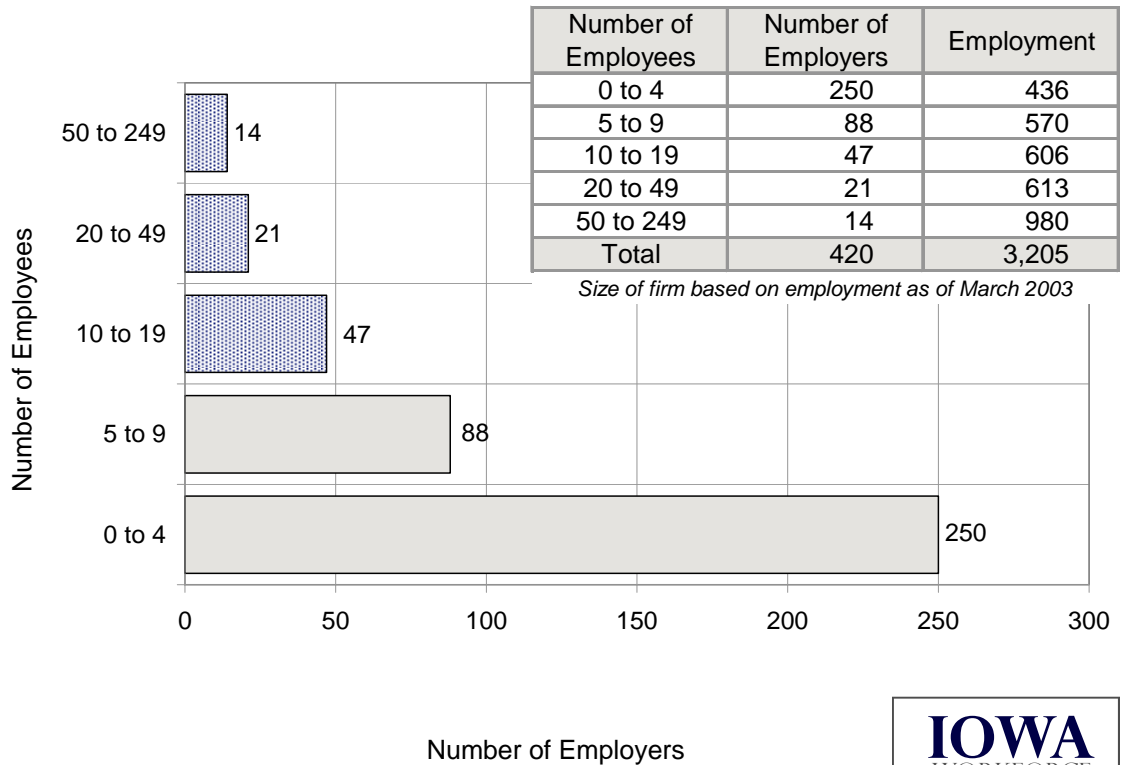
