
# **WASHINGTON** 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE

#### **Executive Summary**

As of 2003, Washington County's largest private sector was Trade, representing 20.88 percent (1,497) of the county's total covered employment of 7,170. The county's total employment decreased by 1.51 percent since 2002, but the average annual wage increased by 5.10 percent to \$24,265 for all industries.

Washington County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$467 for 2003. This was an increase of 5.18 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was Wholesale Trade, averaging \$696 with gross total wages of \$19.4 million. This sector also had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 9.26 percent (\$59) between 2002 and 2003.




