# WEBSTER 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE


#### **Executive Summary**

As of 2003, Webster County's largest private sector was Trade, representing 18.48 percent (3,509) of the county's total covered employment of 18,984. The county's total employment decreased by 0.59 percent since 2002, but the average annual wage increased by 2.29 percent to \$29,345 for all industries.

Webster County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$564 for 2003. This was an increase of 2.17 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was Manufacturing, averaging \$915 with gross total wages of \$111.6 million. The Finance, Insurance & Real Estate sector had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 9.38 percent (\$56) between 2002 and 2003.






