# WINNEBAGO 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE


#### **Executive Summary**

As of 2003, Winnebago County's largest private sector was Education & Health Services, representing 21.07 percent (1,079) of the county's total covered employment of 5,122. Over 80 percent of this sector's employment is in the Nursing Care Facilities industry. The county's total employment decreased by 2.59 percent since 2002, but the average annual wage increased by 2.01 percent to \$22,489 for all industries.

Winnebago County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$432 for 2003. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was Transportation & Utilities, averaging \$648 with gross total wages of \$7.0 million. This sector also had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 80.50 percent (\$289) and largest decrease in employment, 52.81 percent (235) between 2002 and 2003.






