
WORTH 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE

Executive Summary

As of 2003, Worth County's largest private sector was Manufacturing, representing 23.17 percent (370) of the county's total covered employment of 1,597. Although the county's total employment decreased by 0.99 percent since 2002, the average annual wage increased by 1.91 percent to \$23,120 for all industries.

Worth County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$445 for 2003. This was an increase of 2.06 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was Natural Resources & Mining, averaging \$764 with gross total wages of \$0.59 million. This sector also had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 58.18 percent (\$281) between 2002 and 2003, yet reported one of the largest decreases in employment (37.50 percent).




