## Players Win Big 10 and Big 12 'Sports Fantasy'Trips

## ‘Ultimate’ Drawing is April 21

Subject to cash availability, retailers are asked to pay up to $\$ 600$. For prizes over $\$ 600$ - or any prize except a jackpot for that matter—players may mail their signed winning ticket with a claim form to the Iowa Lottery headquarters.

Retailers should have received (or will soon be receiving) an updated "Under 21 sign" from the Iowa Lottery, the Iowa Grocery Industry Association and the Petroleum Marketers and Convenience Stores of Iowa. The Iowa Lottery is committed to ensuring that only legal-aged people purchase lottery tickets and retailers have been doing a good job in helping us achieve that goal. The orange signs list the year a person must be born on or before in order to purchase either lottery products, liquor or tobacco. We appreciate retailers’ vigilance in preventing underage sales.

## Bellevue Woman Ends 'Bad Luck' Curse With \$100,000 Powerball Win

A northeast Iowa woman thinks her bad luck days might be over.

Lori Behrens of Bellevue won $\$ 100,000$ in the Dec. 22 Powerball ${ }^{\circledR}$ drawing. She purchased her ticket at the 16th Street Auto/Truck Plaza, 1215E.
Sixteenth St. in Dubuque.

Behrens just recently claimed her prize at the Iowa Lottery's regional office in Cedar Rapids.

She said she had no idea that she had purchased a winning ticket until the stack of tickets she and her husband had purchased started to catch up with them.
"It was just before Christmas [when I bought the ticket]," she said. "I've had it for over a month and didn't know it. We were just checking [our tickets] on the computer and found out through the Internet."

The winning Powerball numbers for the Dec. 22 drawing were: 2-7-11-24-31. The Powerball was 18. The Power Playâ multiplier was 5.

If Behrens had chosen to play the Power Play, she would have won half a million dollars.

## Players Can Get Power Pack Through March 5

For two weeks beginning Feb. 20, Iowa Lottery players can purchase \$3 in Powerball with a \$3 Power Play on one ticket and pay only $\$ 5$.

The lottery's "Power Pack" offer will be good on qualifying plays purchased through March 5.

## Use Shortcut To Sell Power Pack

Retailers should use the Extrema icon on the main screen or the "Power Pack" choice on the SciScan 3000 to sell the Power Pack. On the Extrema, all clerks have to do is touch the yellow "Power Pack" icon. The terminal will ask them, "Are you sure you want to purchase the Powerball ticket?" When they choose "yes," the $\$ 3$ Powerball with a $\$ 3$ Power Play ticket will print. On the SciScan 3000, clerks should choose "01-Online Sale" and then "06Power Pack" to make the sale. The SciScan will also ask for confirmation of "F1-Yes" or "F2-No" before printing the ticket.

## Deal Applies to All Plays On One Ticket

If a player purchases more than this minimum purchase, they'll still receive $\$ 1$ off their purchase as long as the play is on one ticket. For example, if a player purchases \$5 in Powerball with a \$5 Power Play ( $\$ 10$ total value), they'd receive $\$ 1$ off so the plays would cost $\$ 9$. They just need to make that minimum $\$ 3$ Powerball with a \$3 Power Play purchase to be eligible to receive the $\$ 1$-off discount. This offer will also work if a player uses a play slip or if the clerk makes a manual entry, as long as the player makes the minimum purchase and the play is on one ticket.

## ‘Super Cashman’ Pull-tab Here to Save The Day!

"Super Cashman" hopes to rescue some big sales for you!

Play by peeling apart the five tabs located on the back of the ticket. Three symbols are printed under each tab. Check all five tab areas. If three consecutive symbols printed vertically or diagonally under any of the tabs match identically any of the winning combinations shown on the ticket front, the player wins the corresponding prize. The arrow connecting the symbols indicates you are a winner.
