State parks open for fall and winter camping

- Parks are open year-round for camping. Because each park is unique, plan your visit by checking out individual <u>state</u> <u>park web pages</u> ahead of time or call the park to be sure facilities are available. You can also find out park winterizing plans on the state park <u>alerts-and-closures page</u>.
- Electricity is still running at modern campsites.
- **Modern restrooms and showers are closed** in most state parks by the last week of October. Pit toilets are still available.
- Water has been turned off, but some parks still have water available from hydrants.
