Public access computers, Wi-Fi, public printing, and in-person reference and information services will be available at the Law Library during regular business hours, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

- Online Resources: Use your State Library card to access databases, full text journals and articles from Gale and premier reference materials from Credo. Learn a new language with Transparent Language, or use Chilton Library to find repair manuals and maintenance schedules for your vehicle.
- <u>lowa Publications Online:</u> Use this web-based depository to locate documents created by state agencies for the public.
- <u>lowa Heritage Digital Collections:</u> Free access to digital collections from a variety of lowa cultural institutions.
- <u>State Data Center:</u> The source for population, housing, business, and government statistics about lowa.
