### **Benefit Year - 2018**

Enrollment and Change is over and new health care plans for many begin January 1.

If you will be covered by State of Iowa insurance in 2018, you will receive a new identification card in the mail from Wellmark before the beginning of the year. It will have one important change. In the past, the card listed the name of the provider network - Blue Access or Alliance Select. This year, it will also list the plan option name – Iowa Choice or National Choice.

Knowing which option you chose and which network is tied to that option is important, especially when you want to learn more about your coverage. The Iowa Choice option uses the Blue Access Network and the National Choice Option uses the Alliance Select network. You can search providers and facilities and how those relate to your coverage on the Wellmark website by member number or by the provider network. After January 1, if you search by network, please note the Iowa Choice option uses the Blue Access network and the National Choice option uses the Alliance Select network. You will NOT be able to search by the Iowa Choice or National Choice option names. Your plan option and its corresponding network will be printed on your card.

# <u>Introducing "Doctor on Demand" – A New, Convenient Way to Access Care</u>

Are you worried when your child wakes up with a high fever in the middle of the night? Or maybe you need to connect with a doctor and want to do it from the comfort and convenience of your own home or while you're traveling? In 2018, with both the lowa Choice and National Choice health insurance options, you can see and talk with a board-certified doctor right on your smartphone or tablet from almost anywhere at any time.

Through "Doctor on Demand," your virtual doctor can treat most common medical conditions, such as colds, flu, bronchitis, sinus infections, urinary tract infections, sore throats, allergies, fever, headache, pink eye, skin conditions, and more. The doctor can even prescribe medication if needed.

As an added benefit, using "Doctor on Demand" requires only a \$10 copay after January 1 under the Iowa Choice and National Choice plan options, and is a 10 percent coinsurance for SPOC-covered employees on the Alliance Select plan.

## Health Flexible Spending Account (FSA) Carryover Change

Effective January 2018, the Health FSA carryover provision will change. Funds will carry over for one year only, instead of carrying over from year to year. Participants with carryover funds from previous years will still be able to use them in 2018, but unused funds at the end of 2018 will be forfeited. Only funds contributed in 2018 may be carried over into 2019.

## <u>Using your Health Flexible Spending Account</u> (FSA) is now more convenient

It's now easier than ever to use your Health Flexible Spending Account (FSA) when you choose these convenient options:

#### Pay with your ASIFlex card

The ASIFlex Card (a limited-use pre-paid debit card) provides an easy way to pay for eligible out-of-pocket health care expenses. The convenient card allows you to pay the merchant or health care provider directly from your Health FSA.

To add the Debit Card option to your account, log into your ASIFlex account at <a href="www.asiflex.com">www.asiflex.com</a>. Click on "Participant Services," complete the form and submit it to ASI (our FSA vendor). It's that easy!

#### **Automatic Reimbursement**

If you prefer not to have an ASIFlex card, Health FSA Automatic Reimbursement offers an alternative by allowing ASI to reimburse you for your share of eligible health expenses processed by Wellmark or Delta Dental. Once you pay for a health product or service, the expense information is sent directly to ASI and, after review for eligibility, ASI will send you the reimbursement from any available funds in your pre-tax Health FSA account.

To add the Automatic Reimbursement option to your account, simply log into your ASIFlex account at <a href="https://www.asiflex.com">www.asiflex.com</a>. Click on "Participant Services" and follow the prompts. Please note, you can choose either the ASIFlex card OR the Automatic Reimbursement option, not both.

#### "Go Green" with your FSAs

Receive payments faster and stop receiving paper confirmations for your Health and/or Dependent Care FSAs by requesting to receive both electronically. To save yourself trips to the bank and your mailbox, complete and submit the Paperless Notification & Payment Authorization Form (<a href="https://das.iowa.gov/sites/default/files/hr/fsa/documents/ASI\_dir\_dep\_pprless\_form.pdf">https://das.iowa.gov/sites/default/files/hr/fsa/documents/ASI\_dir\_dep\_pprless\_form.pdf</a>) to ASI. ### <u>Deferred Compensation Retirement Investors'</u> <u>Club (RIC) Update</u>

The lowa Retirement Investors' Club (RIC) is the State's voluntary retirement savings benefit allowing you to set aside a portion of your current wages for future use as income to supplement your pension (IPERS, POR, Judicial) and Social Security benefits. Your pre-tax and/or post-tax Roth contributions receive a State match benefit of up to \$75 per month (\$900 per year). Contributions (minimum of \$25 per month) are made through automatic payroll deductions and can be changed or stopped at any time. Enrollment is always open. RIC accounts have no vesting requirements.

#### 2018 contribution limit increases

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has increased the maximum contribution limits for 2018 (see limits at https://das.iowa.gov/457/IRS\_limits).

#### **Currently contributing employees**

You may change your payroll deductions at any time. If you want to request deduction changes for January 2018, you must submit a completed RIC Account Form by December 29, 2017.

Do you know if you are saving enough? At no cost to you, your provider representative can help determine if your current savings rate is on target to meet your retirement income goals.
