Executive Summary


As of 2014, Iowa Workforce Development's (IWD) Region 14's largest private industry was Manufacturing, representing 18.4 percent (4,541) of the region's total covered employment of 24,723. The region's total employment increased by 0.1 percent since 2013, while the average annual wage increased by 4.0 percent to \$33,641 for all industries. The Transportation and Utilities industry posted the largest employment percentage increase of 6.7 percent during 2014.

IWD's Region 14 average weekly wage for all industries was \$647 for 2014. This was an increase of 4.0 percent since 2013. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was in Wholesale Trade averaging \$875. Between 2013 and 2014, the Finance, Insurance, and Real Estate sector reported the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 7.7 percent.




Reporting Units by Industry in 2014

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
Size of Firm



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
Labor Force 2014
