Executive Summary

In 2015, the **finance & insurance** sector comprised 6.0 percent of all employment in lowa (private and public sector). This high-wage sector reported an average annual wage of \$71,841 for the year, which was 62.9 percent higher than the statewide average of \$44,094 for all industries.

Since 2006, this sector has added 5,026 jobs (5.8%) and the average annual wage has grown by \$18,036 (33.5%). Despite this trend of long-term growth, **finance & insurance** contracted slightly after the recession and lost 1,788 jobs between 2008 and 2011. However, the sector began growing again in 2012 and has since surpassed its 2008 peak.

Despite the high wages relative to other industries in lowa, wages for **finance & insurance** are 28.4 percent lower than the national average of \$100,286; however, lowa's wages are fairly in line with other states in our region.

Women make up the majority of employees in this sector, holding 63.5 percent of all jobs.





What is Finance and Insurance?

This sector comprises firms primarily Engaged in financial transactions (transactions involving the creation, liquidation, or change in ownership of financial assets) and/or in facilitating financial transactions.


Three principal types of activities are identified: raising funds by taking deposits issuing and/or securities, pooling of risk by underwriting insurance and annuities, and providing specialized facilitating or services supporting financial intermediation, insurance and employee benefit programs. In addition, monetary authorities charged with monetary control are included in this sector.

2015 Industry Breakout by Employment in Iowa


Finance & Insurance NAICS Industry Coding



Employers

In 2015, there was an average of 6,495 locations employing 91,720 people in the **finance & insurance** industries across lowa.

The vast majority of finance & insurance employment (94.7 percent) is represented by only two sub-sectors: insurance carriers and related activities report 46.6 percent, credit intermediation or related activities accounts for 48.1 percent of sector employees.


Insurance carriers and related activities has a higher average wage than Credit Intermediation or Related Activities, \$76,016 and \$65,096 respectively.


