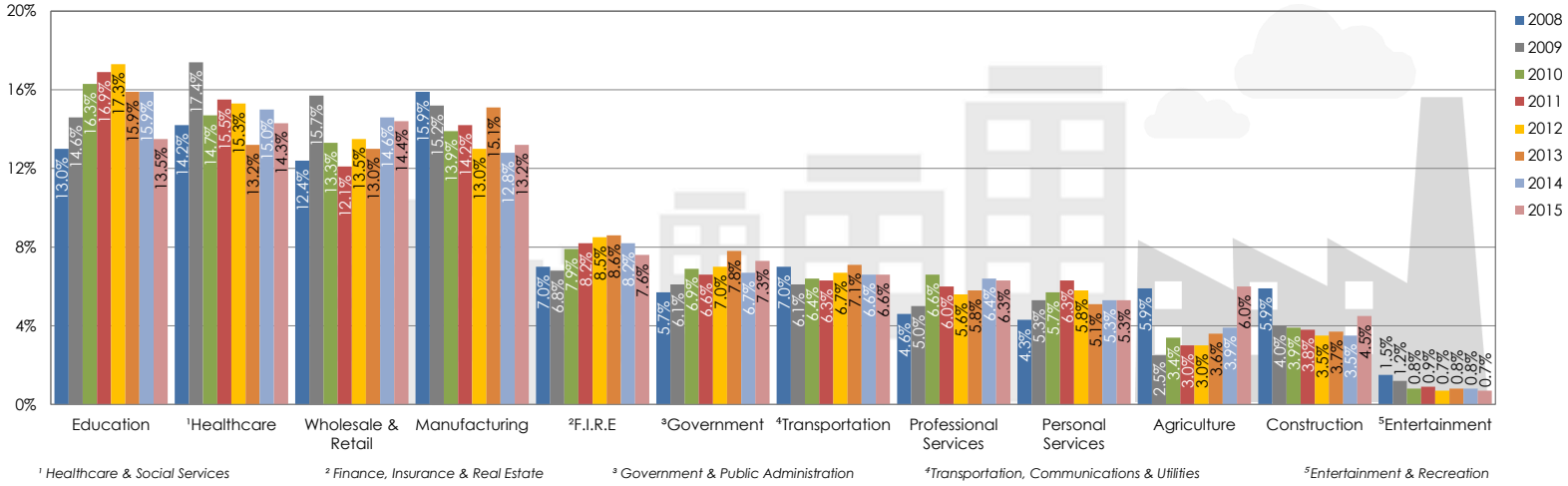

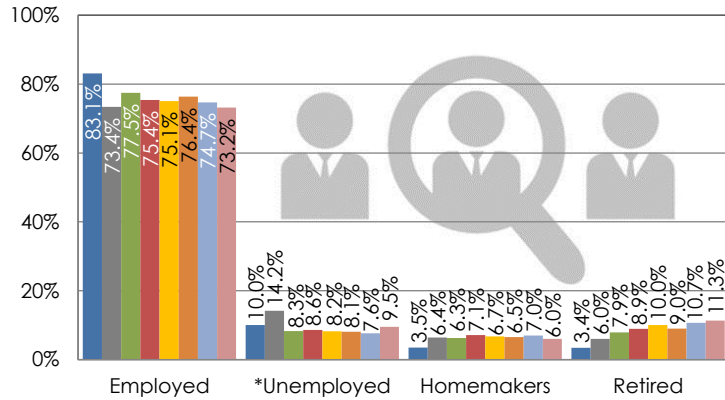

Industries of the Employed (ordered by most recent year, high-to-low):

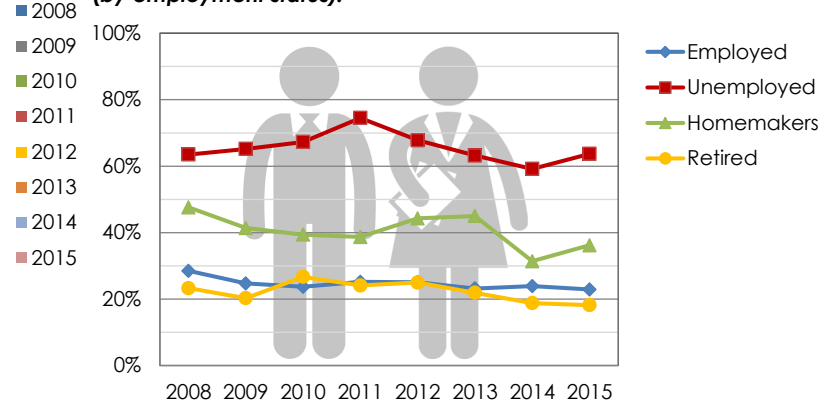

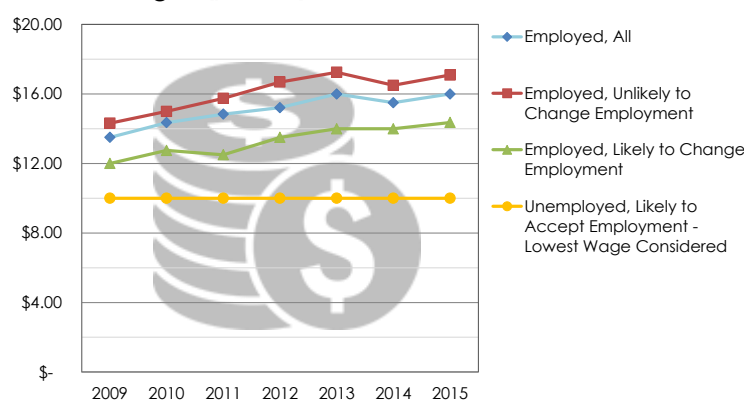

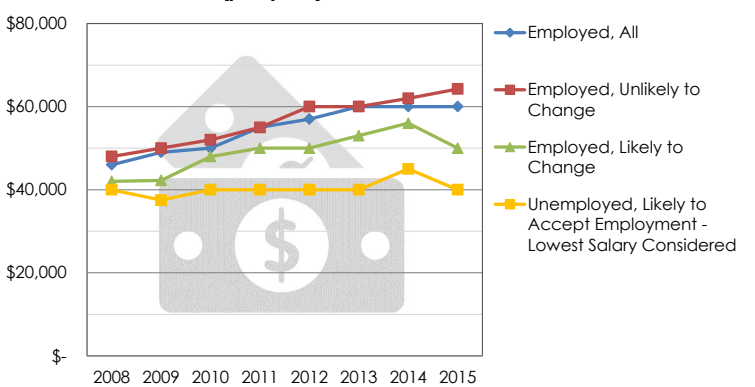
### Likelihood to Change/Accept Employment (by employment status):



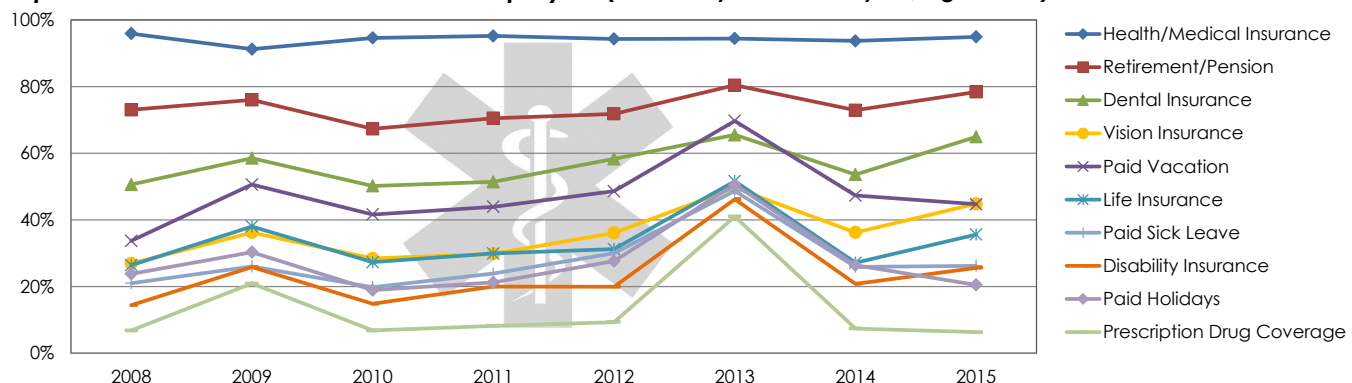
### Median Wages (per hour):

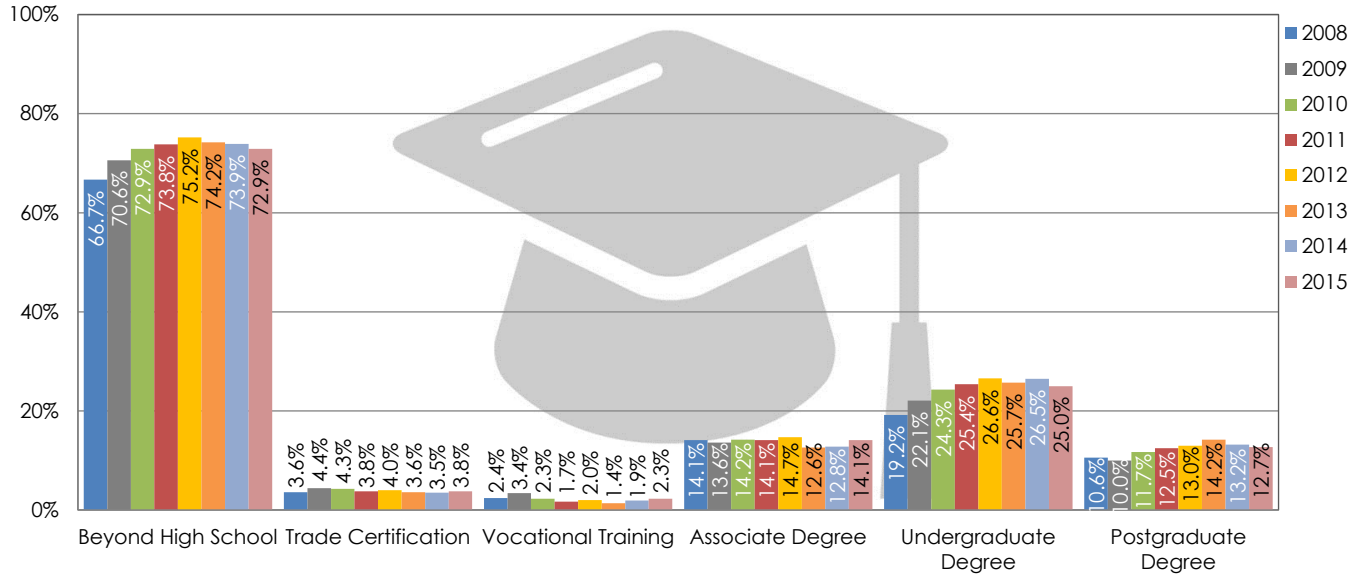


### Top Current Benefits of the Full-Time Employed (ordered by most recent year, high-to-low):

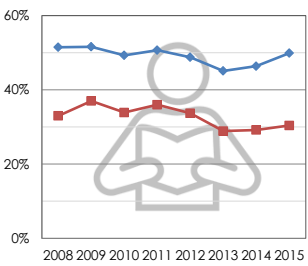

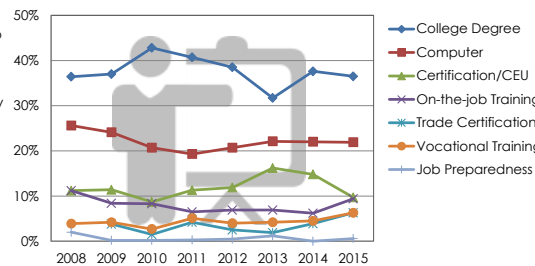
## Education Level of the Employed:



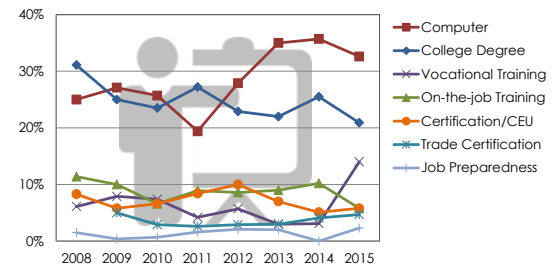

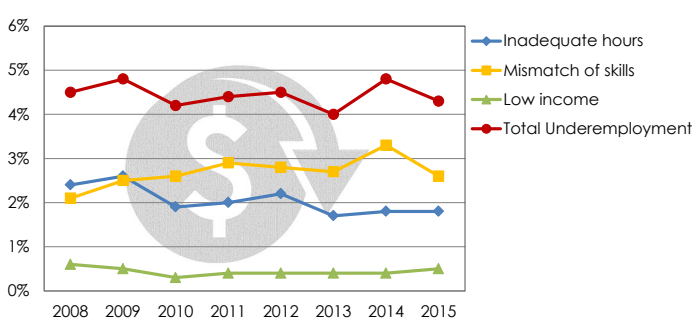
## Employed, Likely to Change - Desired Training (ordered by most recent year, high-to-low):



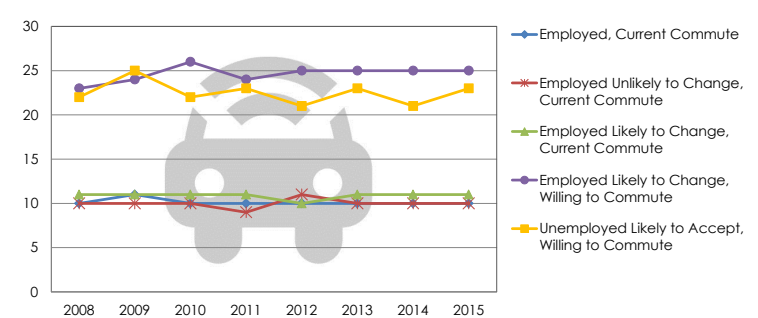
## Unemployed, Likely to Accept - Desired Training (ordered by most recent year, high-to-low):
