## Records Are Made to Be Broken!

The 70th Annual Iowa State Fair Photography Salon has done it again. Right when I think records have been set that will "never" be broken, Iowa photographers prove me wrong. Words like fantastic, incredible and unbelievable come to mind when I think about the "number" of photographs that we received this year.

The 2009 Photography Salon received a record breaking 4,577 photographs. To put it in perspective, this is almost a 1,000 more than in 2008 and almost 200 more than our previous record in 2007. Needless to say, the competition was definitely tough this year. After the 12 rounds of judging was finished, 875 (19%) of the 4,577 photographs were selected for display by our panel of three judges. This means that only "one" out of "five" photographs entered were selected for display. Talk about tough competition!

The competition was just as tough "between" the photographers. We had a near record breaking 1,493 photographers enter "at least" one photograph this year. Of the photographers who entered, 608 (41%) will have at least "one" photograph on display. Want to know how tough the competition really was? Only 11 (less than 1%) of the 1,493 photographers will have all "four" of their photographs on display this year. What an amazing accomplishment!


Stop for a moment and think about trying to judge almost 5,000 photographs. The judges were given an almost impossible task this year. They have selected some truly amazing photographs for display. Please join me in thanking them for all their time, effort and commitment. What an incredible task!

We also broke a couple of other records this year. We now have a record number of Sponsors. Our 25 Sponsors donated a record breaking \$5,725 to the winning photographers. The Iowa State Fair also donated another \$1,950 in prize money. Thanks to our Sponsors and the Iowa State Fair a record breaking \$7,675 was awarded to the photographers.

There is absolutely no way that this exhibit would even be possible without the support of the world's greatest staff and a host of volunteers. A special thank you also goes out to the Iowa State Fair Entry Department. Imagine trying to process 1,493 Entry Forms, not to mention having to enter 4,577 titles. Please join me in thanking everyone for their tremendous efforts.

It has been an "amazing" year for the Photography Salon. As "State Fair Time" approaches I would like to turn the clock "back" for just a minute. For some of the photographers "State Fair Time" began months ago when they were outside in the cold and snow taking photographs. For many of the photographers "State Fair Time" began back in early June when they started mailing in their photographs. For the majority of the photographers "State Fair Time" will rapidly "fast forward" when they see pages 70 to 73. Please join me in thanking them for sharing their incredible images with all of us and for starting "so" early for 2010.

### JOANN BOEHMER

JoAnn Boehmer graduated from Arizona State University with a Master of Fine Arts degree. Boehmer has taught both traditional and digital photography at Iowa State University since 1999. She also manages the photography labs and student workers in the College of Design. Before coming to Iowa JoAnn taught at universities in Pennsylvania, Ohio, Oregon and Arizona. **HOW TO ENTER**

Entry Rules and Entry Forms will be available "online" at [www.iowastatefair.org](http://www.iowastatefair.org) by May 1, 2010.

**ENTRY RULES\***

1. **JURIED COMPETITION:** Only those photos selected by the panel of judges will be "exhibited."
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Photos previously "exhibited" at the Iowa State Fair are NOT eligible for entry.
3. **ORIGINALITY:** Photographers must use their "own" ideas and concepts when creating their photos. Do NOT "copy" or "duplicate" the ideas of other photographers or previous winners.
4. **ENTRIES:** Each photographer can enter up to "four" photos. There is a limit of "one" photo per class.
5. **CLASSES:** Classes are determined by the "main" subject matter of each photo. The "same" photo or "similar" photo cannot be entered in multiple classes. To increase your chances of being displayed your photos should be of entirely "different" subjects.
6. **BACKING:** All photos "must" be mounted on 11" x 14" foam core that is "at least" 1/8" thick. Do NOT use "mat board" or "styrene." NOTE: Due to the heat and humidity, it is recommended that photos be dry mounted. (Available at most art supply stores and frame shops.)
7. **PHOTO SIZE:** Photos can be any size up to and including 11" x 14". (Note Entry Rule #6)
8. **MATS:** We judge your photo NOT the mat. Mat colors should NOT compete with your photo. Mats are optional.
9. **TITLES:** We judge your photo NOT the title. Please "limit" titles to three or four words.
10. **ENTRY:** Your name, photo title, date of photo and other text must NOT appear on front of entry.
11. **PRESENTATION:** All photos must be unframed. Do NOT cover entry with cellophane, acetate or glass. There should be NO hooks or wires attached to the back of entries. There should be NO spray adhesive or self-stick adhesive "exposed" that could damage another person's photo.
12. **REPRODUCTION:** Iowa State Fair reserves the right to reproduce in any form any work submitted.
13. **LOSS OR DAMAGE:** All photos will be handled with care. However, the Iowa State Fair is NOT responsible for any loss or damage to entries.
14. **QUESTIONS:** Please contact the Iowa State Fair Entry Department at (515) 262-3111 ext. 267.

\* Read next year's entry form carefully. There may be additional changes in the entry rules and classes.

**NOTE:** Any photo that does NOT meet the above requirements will NOT be judged. Entry fees will NOT be refunded.

**ENTRY SCHEDULE AND ENTRY DEADLINE**

**ENTRY FEE:** \$5 per photo. (Maximum of 4 photos.) Make checks payable to the Iowa State Fair.

**ENTRIES ACCEPTED:** Saturday, June 26 and Sunday, June 27 from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. in the Cultural Center at the Iowa State Fairgrounds.

**ENTRY BY MAIL:** Do NOT mail *before* Monday, June 7. Entries by mail *must* be postmarked by "midnight" Monday, June 21. To enter by mail you *must* include your "entry form," "entry fee" and "photos" in the same package. Send your package to: Iowa State Fair, Photography Salon, P.O. **ENTRY DEADLINE:** Any photos received *after* 4 p.m. on Sunday, June 27 will NOT be judged.

**JUDGING RESULTS**

**RESULTS:** A results postcard will be mailed to entrants "one" week *before* the Photography Salon Reception. A list of exhibitors who have one or more photos accepted for display will be posted on the Iowa State Fair website at [www.iowastatefair.org](http://www.iowastatefair.org) prior to the Reception. The complete results will be posted *after* the Reception. The judges' decisions are final.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S COMMENTS**

Entry Rules #4 and #5 were created to help increase, NOT decrease, your chances of getting "in the show." During the first of twelve rounds of judging, all four of your photos are displayed at once for the judges. Each photo is then judged independently. It takes "one" vote to get "in the show" and "three" votes to "win an award." When the judges see four photos of the "same" baby, dog, cat, bird or flower they simply move on to the next group of photos. It is "your" job to pick out "your" best photo of each subject, NOT the judges. To increase your chances of getting "in the show," your four photos should be of entirely "different" subjects. It is also "your" job as a photographer to "pre-judge" your own work. The judges are looking for creativity. They want "photographs" NOT "snapshots." Your goal as a photographer is to, "Show us the world as we have never seen it before!" How you accomplish this is the "art" of photography.

**SUGGESTIONS**

- ▶ Learn how to operate your camera. Read the owner's manual. Be able to use all the various modes.
- ▶ Take a class or join a camera club. Give yourself photo assignments. Shoot specifically for one class.
- ▶ Do NOT "copy" or "duplicate" the ideas of other photographers or previous winners.
- ▶ Learn how to "see" light. Photography is all about the light!
- ▶ Learn about "film speeds," "shutter speeds" and "apertures." Apertures help you control "depth of field."
- ▶ Run film/pixels through your camera. The "more" you shoot the "better" you will get.
- ▶ Using the "smallest" JPG setting will get you "more" photos on your card and "less" photos in the fair.
- ▶ Get closer. Crop tighter. Crop your with your lens! Image quality is lost if you always crop in Photoshop.
- ▶ Change your angle of view. Get off your feet. Change your lens. Take off your "favorite" lens!
- ▶ Don't suffer from "horizontal's disease!" Buy a "vertical" grip or rotate your camera to fit your subject.
- ▶ If your horizon is "not" level, it is "not" in the show. Buy a "grid" screen or use the feature on your camera.
- ▶ Watch for background distractions. Look carefully in your viewfinder "before" taking your photo.
- ▶ Judges "cannot" judge what they "cannot" see. Recommend photos be "at least" 8" x 10" or larger.
- ▶ What is your main subject? If the judges "cannot" tell, it is "out" of the show.
- ▶ Is your main subject "in" focus? If it is "out" of focus, it is "out" of the show.
- ▶ Print quality is everything. Use a good photo lab or make sure you have a high quality home printer.
- ▶ Color calibrate your monitor "at least" once a month.
- ▶ Black & White photos should be Black & White — NOT Black & "Blue."
- ▶ Do NOT over-sharpen your photos!
- ▶ Do NOT over-saturate your images! Colors are becoming totally unrealistic.
- ▶ Do NOT put your subject in the center! Learn the "Rule of Thirds."
- ▶ Composition! Composition! Composition!

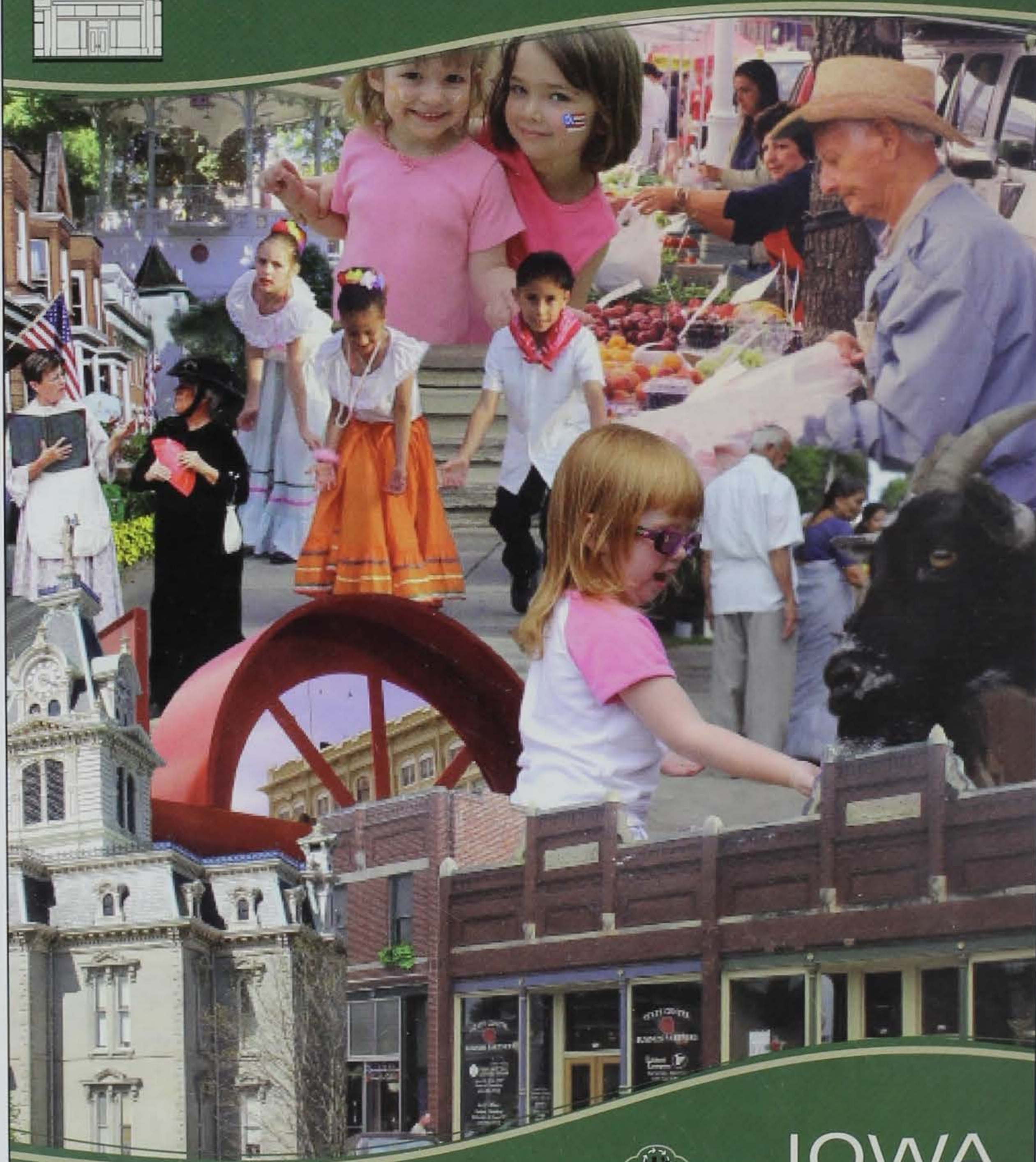

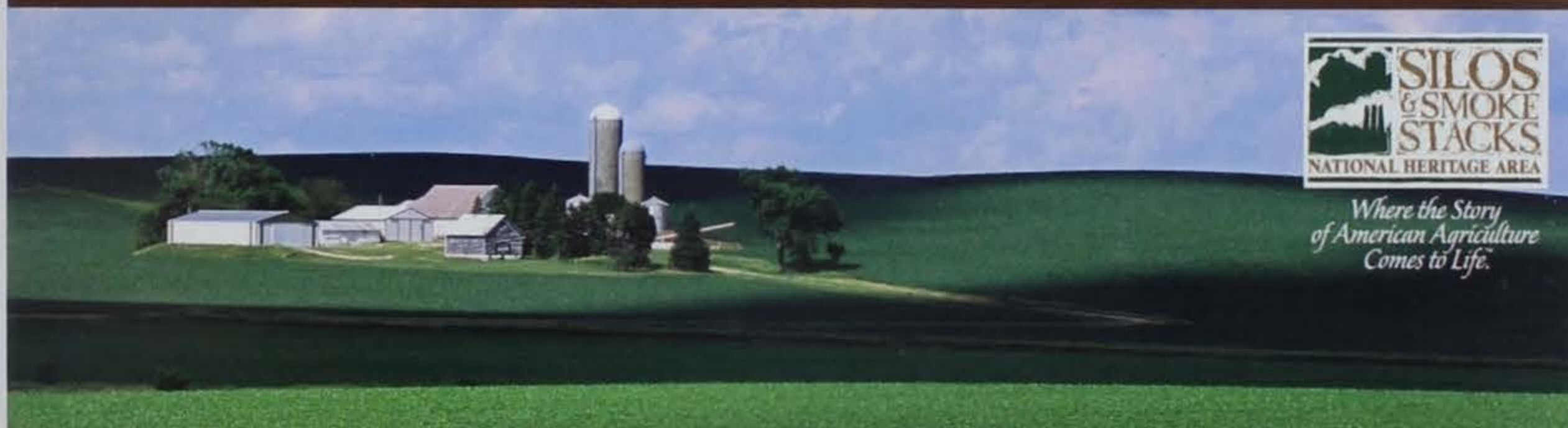

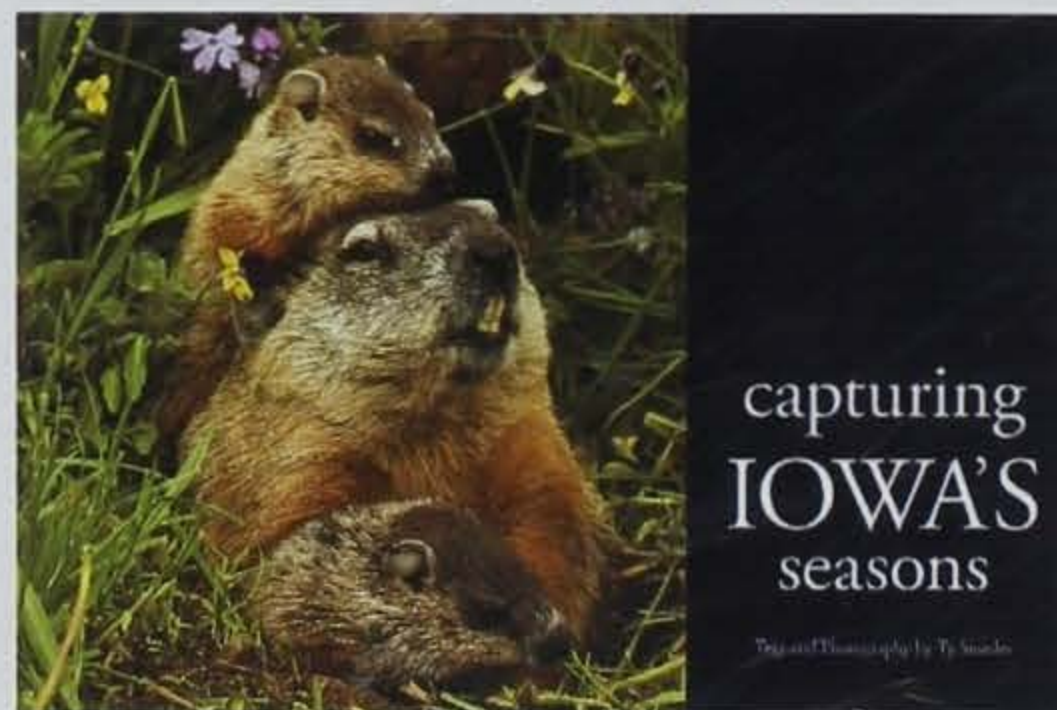
