DNR enforcement actions

DES MOINES – DNR staff work with individuals, businesses and communities to help them protect our natural resources by complying with state and federal laws. This approach is very effective. In the few cases where compliance cannot be achieved, the DNR issues enforcement actions. The following list summarizes recent enforcement actions. Consent Orders A consent order is issued as an alternative to issuing an administrative order. A consent order indicates that the DNR has voluntarily entered into a legally enforceable agreement with the other party.

Dickinson County

Terrafact, Inc.

Pay an administrative penalty of \$750 and a Supplemental Environmental Project payment of \$2,250 to the Dickinson County Conservation Board.

Administrative Orders

Responsible parties have 30 days to appeal the order or 60 days to pay the penalty.

Polk County

Ram Development

Cease illegal burning, comply with air quality permits; and pay an administrative penalty of \$10,000.

Poweshiek County

Convenience Stores Leasing and Management, LLC

Amendment to Administrative Order 2017-UT-06. Remove penalty assessment.

Scott County

AKD Investments, LLC

Amendment to Administrative Order 2017-UT-05. Remove penalty assessment.
