Communities, wastewater utilities, and consultants interested in applying for or currently working on a State Revolving Fund (SRF) Water Resource Restoration Sponsored Project or a SRF General Non-point Source Loan for stream stabilization projects should note the upcoming Iowa River Restoration Toolbox Training Workshops.

The Iowa River Restoration Toolbox was developed by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to assist designers and reviewers of stream stabilization and restoration projects by providing proven techniques that incorporate natural materials and are appropriate for Iowa streams and rivers. The goal of the Toolbox is to assist design teams with the evaluation of streams and the selection of suitable practices that will result in successful projects.
