- The Profile of Older Americans is an annual summary of critical statistics related to the
 older population in the United States. Relying primarily on data offered by the U.S.
 Census Bureau, the Profile illustrates the shifting demographics of Americans age 65
 and older. It includes key topic areas such as income, living arrangements, education,
 health, and caregiving. The 2018 Profile also incorporates a new special section on
 emergency and disaster preparedness.



As of 2017, 5.5 million seniors age 60 and older in the U.S. experience food insecurity.
 As the senior population grows, so will the challenge of ensuring older adults have access to enough nutritious food. Feeding America compiled data on senior hunger in the United States.
