



Reportable Diseases By Year 1930 - 2017

Updated Annually



This report, released annually, provides the total number of reportable diseases, confirmed and probable, identified by IDPH each year since 1930. Due to the nature of some diseases and how the reportable disease system has changed, the number of diseases reported many years ago are considered estimates and should be used for general/informational purposes only. It should also be noted that specific diseases have been added to or removed from the reportable disease list over the years. For example, West Nile Virus was not reportable in Iowa until the early 2000's, therefore there are no values in the table for West Nile Virus for years prior.
