
Immunization Schedule with Combination Vaccines



The above is a suggested schedule using combination vaccines. For alternatives, details and catch-up, refer to the most current *Recommended Immunization Schedules* from CDC.

- 1. A dose of HepB vaccine is not necessary at 4 months if doses are given at birth and 2 months, but may be included as part of combination vaccine.
- 2. The 6 month dose is not needed if Rotarix is used exclusively for both dose 1 and 2 in rotavirus vaccine series.
- 3. The 6 month Hib dose is not needed if PedvaxHIB is used exclusively for the 2nd and 4th month doses.
- 4. A child may need 1 or 2 doses of influenza vaccine based on previous vaccination history. Refer to most current influenza vaccine recommendations.
- 5. ACIP recommends whenever feasible, use the same vaccine manufacturer's DTaP for each dose in the series, however vaccination should not be delayed based on the type of DTaP previously administered.
- 6. CDC recommends administration of separate MMR and Varicella vaccines for the 12-15 month dose; however MMRV is acceptable based on clinical discretion.
