WHAT'S NEW FOR 2005

- A \$1 Help Us Stop Hunger (HUSH) fee is added to every deer license. See p. 30.
- The definition of antlerless deer has changed. See below.
- Eligibility for landowner deer licenses has changed, as well as the penalties for obtaining them illegally. See p. 7.
- The number of reduced fee licenses available to landowners and tenants has increased. See p. 23.
- A new antlerless-deer only season will be held Nov. 25 - 27. See p. 22.
- The January Antlerless-deer only season will be extended in southern Iowa for 7 days. Centerfire rifles will be allowed during the extension. See p. 21.

License Requirements and Fees

A deer hunter may not carry a deer hunting license or transportation tag issued to another hunter.

LICENSE TYPES

Resident hunters may obtain the following types of deer licenses:

Paid Any-deer Licenses are valid statewide in the season selected by the hunter at the time the license is purchased. Any-deer licenses are valid for taking deer of either sex. An individual may have one Any-deer license for the Bow Season and one Any-deer license for one of the following seasons: Youth/Disabled, Early Muzzleloader, Late Muzzleloader, Shotgun Season 1, or Shotgun Season 2.

Exceptions:

- Youth/Disabled Season hunters see p. 22.
- There is a quota of 7,500 Early Muzzleloader Season licenses. These are sold first come first served until the quota is filled or until the last day of the Early Muzzleloader Season.

Paid Antlerless-only Licenses are valid for taking only antlerless deer and only in the county and season selected by the hunter at the time the license is purchased. **An antlerless deer is a deer with no forked antler.** Quotas for Antlerless-only licenses are established for each county to direct the additional harvest of does to areas with the greatest number of deer. The quota is the maximum number

of Antlerless-only licenses that will be sold for each county for all deer seasons. Licenses are sold first come first served until the quota is reached.

Antlerless-only licenses are available in most seasons. In the two following antlerless-only seasons, no antlered deer may be harvested; hunters may take only does to reduce the size of the deer herd:

NEW - A 3-day Antlerless-only deer season will be held beginning the Friday after Thanksgiving. Hunters may participate regardless of any other deer licenses that have been purchased. Shotguns, muzzleloaders, handguns and bows may be used. The regular bow season will remain open during this season.

The January Antlerless-only season will be open statewide from January 11- 22. Hunters may participate regardless of any other deer licenses that have been purchased. Shotguns, muzzleloaders,

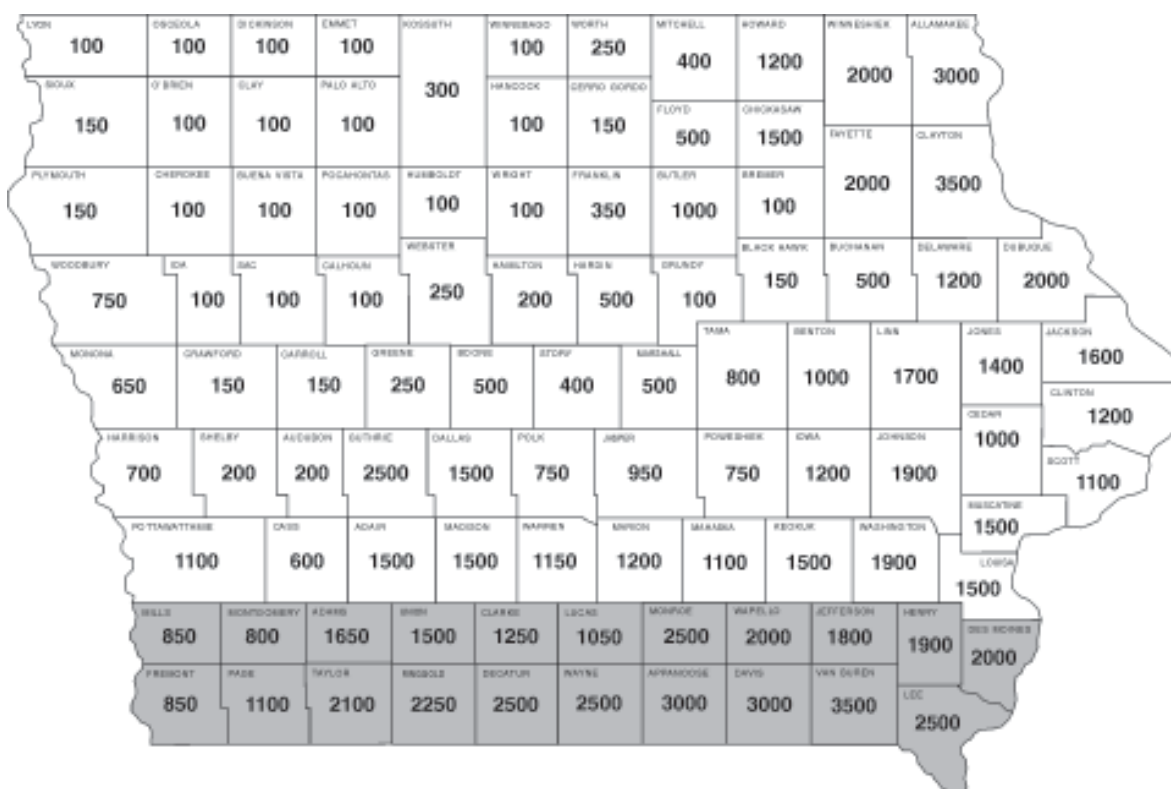
handguns and bows may be used during the statewide segment.

NEW - The January Antlerless-only season will be extended for 7 days from Jan. 23 - 29, 2006, in the following counties in southern Iowa: Mills, Fremont, Montgomery, Page, Adams, Taylor, Union, Ringgold, Clarke, Decatur, Lucas, Wayne, Monroe, Appanoose, Wapello, Davis, Jefferson, Van Buren, Henry, Lee, Des Moines. Hunters with an unfilled January Antlerless-only that is valid in one of the above counties may participate during the extended period. Center-fire rifles, as described on p. 24, will be allowed along with bows, shotguns, muzzleloaders and handguns.

Hunters may purchase multiple Antlerless-only licenses in some seasons and season combinations subject to the following restrictions:

- Beginning August 15, hunters may purchase a total of 3 Antlerless-only licenses in one or a

combination of the following seasons: Disabled Hunter, Bow, Early Muzzleloader, Late Muzzleloader, Shotgun 1 or Shotgun 2, and up to 3 Antlerless-only licenses for the January Antlerless-only Season.

- Beginning October 1, an unlimited number of Antlerless-only licenses may be purchased for these seasons until county quotas are reached.
- Beginning November 12, hunters may purchase an unlimited number of Antlerless-only licenses for the November Antlerless-only Season.

Allowable Combinations of Any-deer and Antlerless-only Licenses

A hunter's selection of season for an Any-deer License will affect the seasons in which Antlerless-only licenses may be purchased. The chart on p. 26 - 27 explains the combinations of paid licenses that may be purchased.

BONUS DEER HUNTS

Youth Deer Season. Iowa residents that are ages 12 through 15 are eligible for the Youth Season subject to the following restrictions:

- Youth hunters must have reached their 12th birthday but not reached their 16th birthday on the day they obtain the license.
- The youth must provide proof of having passed a hunter education course sponsored by a state wildlife agency when obtaining the license.
- While hunting, youth hunters must be under the direct supervision of an adult mentor who has a valid Hunting License and has paid the Habitat Fee, if the adult is normally required to have them to hunt. Only one youth hunter per adult mentor.
- The youth hunter and mentor must comply with the blaze orange clothing requirements and all other deer hunting regulations that are in effect during the regular deer seasons.

Youth licenses are Any-deer licenses valid statewide for taking one deer of either sex. Youth hunters may hunt with a bow, shotgun or muzzleloader as defined on p. 23. Youth hunters may also obtain one Any-deer License for Bow, Early Muzzleloader (subject to quota), Late Muzzleloader, Shotgun 1 or Shotgun 2 seasons and

Antlerless-only licenses like any other hunter. See the chart on p. 26 - 27.

A youth who resides with and is a member of the family of a landowner or tenant who is eligible for a Landowner-Tenant Deer License may obtain a Landowner-Tenant License for the Youth Season. The Landowner-Tenant Youth License will count as the one Landowner-Tenant Any-deer License the landowner or tenant family is entitled for all deer seasons.

Severely Disabled Hunter. Persons classified as severely disabled as defined in Iowa Code section 321L.1(8) may hunt during the Youth and Disabled Hunter Season. Severely disabled hunters may hunt with a bow, muzzleloader, shotgun, or handgun (if eligible) as defined on p. 23.

Disabled Hunter licenses are Any-deer licenses valid statewide for taking deer of either sex. This license will be the one paid Any-deer License valid for a firearm season that the individual may purchase. Persons with this license may also purchase one Any-deer License for the Bow Season and multiple Antlerless-only licenses for the Disabled Hunter and Bow seasons (see Paid Antlerless-only licenses on p. 20).

Applications for special licenses for this season may be obtained from the DNR's website at www.iowadnr.com (click on 2005-06 Deer Hunting Season Dates), or by calling 515-281-5918, or by going to the DNR central office in Des Moines or one of the district offices across the state (see p. 3). Nonresidents must obtain their license during the regular nonresident application period in May.

Deer Population Management Zones.

Deer population management zones have been established to reduce high deer numbers in areas where traditional hunting seasons cannot be held - chiefly urban areas and state and county parks. Most licenses are Antlerless-only. Licenses for these hunts will not count in determining the number of licenses an individual may have, or against the county quota for Antlerless-only licenses. Licenses cost the same as regular deer season licenses.

These management zones have individual license quotas and may have different season dates,

license restrictions, and firearm proficiency requirements. For more information, consult the chart on p. 28 - 30 .

Educational Deer Hunts. Some of the deer population management zone hunts are designed to educate young deer hunters in proper hunting and safety practices and to hunt in an ethical manner. These hunts are designated as “**Youth Only**” on the table on p. 28 - 30. Contact the hunt location for more information.

REDUCED FEE LICENSES FOR LANDOWNERS AND TENANTS

Reduced-fee deer licenses are available to qualifying landowners and tenants or their eligible family members. See p. 8 to determine who is eligible. These licenses are valid only on the farm unit of the landowner or tenant. Hunters obtaining these licenses may purchase all of the paid deer licenses otherwise available to other hunters.

Landowner-Tenant Any-deer licenses will be valid for taking deer of either sex during the season selected at the time the license is purchased. The license may be for any season except the November and January Antlerless-only seasons. Landowner-Tenant Any-deer licenses for the shotgun seasons will be valid in both shotgun seasons. Only 1 deer may be tagged.

Landowner-Tenant Antlerless-only licenses will be available to hunters that have obtained a Landowner-Tenant Any-deer license. Landowner-Tenant Antlerless-only licenses will be valid for taking

only antlerless deer. **An antlerless deer is a deer with no visible forked antler.** One Landowner-Tenant Antlerless-only License may be selected for any season. A second Landowner-Tenant Antlerless-only License may be selected for the January Antlerless-only Season.

Reduced-fee Antlerless-only Licenses for any season are available to hunters who have already obtained a Landowner-Tenant Any-deer License. These licenses cost \$12 each. A total of 2 may be purchased.

SPECIAL HUNTING REGULATIONS THAT APPLY TO DEER HUNTING

See p. 12 - 14 for general hunting regulations that may also apply to deer hunters.

Shooting Hours

Shooting hours for all deer seasons are one-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset.

LEGAL WEAPONS

Archery: Longbows, recurve bows, and compound bows shooting broadhead arrows are permitted. No explosive or chemical devices may be attached to the arrow or broadhead. There are no minimum draw weights for bows or minimum diameter for broadheads. Arrows must be at least 18 inches long.

Crossbows are not legal except that a physically disabled person incapable of shooting a bow, as defined on p. 12, may obtain a permit from the DNR to use a crossbow. Applications are available at

Shotguns: 10-, 12-, 16-, and 20-gauge shotguns shooting single slugs only.

Muzzleloaders: Flintlock or percussion cap muzzleloading rifles or muskets between .44 and .775 caliber shooting single projectiles; muzzleloading pistols .44 caliber or larger with a minimum barrel length of 4 inches and no shoulder stock or long barrel modifications. There are no restrictions on in-line or disk-type muzzleloaders. Riflescopes may also be used.

Handguns: Center-fire handguns .357 caliber or larger, shooting straight wall ammunition with expanding-type bullet. Minimum barrel length for all handguns is 4 inches. No shoulder stock or long barrel modifications are allowed.

Only the following center-fire cartridges may be used: .357 Magnum, .357 Maximum, .375 Winchester, .38 Super, .40 S&W, .401 Powermag, 10 mm Auto, .41 Remington Magnum, .41 Action Express, .44 S&W Special, .44 Remington Magnum, .44 Automag, .444 Marlin, .445 Super Mag, .45 ACP, .45 Colt, .45 Super Mag, .45 Winchester Magnum, .45 Silhouette, .451 Detonics, .454 Casull, .45-70 Govt., .460 Rowland, .475 Widley Magnum, .475 Linebaugh, .480 Ruger, .50 Action Express, .50 Linebaugh and .500 S&W Mag.

Hunters age 16 and under may not use any handguns. Hunters ages 17 through 20 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or spouse who is at least 21 years old to use a handgun.

Center-fire rifles: Rifles .24 caliber or larger with a maximum capacity of 6 rounds in the chamber and magazine combined.

Tagging Requirements

An ELSI-issued transportation tag with the date of kill properly shown must be attached to the deer in a manner that is easily visible and which cannot be removed without being mutilated or destroyed. Transportation tags are proof of possession and must remain attached to the carcass until the animal is processed for consumption. All deer must be tagged within 15 minutes after the kill or before they are moved whichever occurs first. The head and antlers (if any) must remain attached to the carcass until it is processed for

consumption.

Hunters in the Youth/Disabled Hunter, Bow, Early Muzzleloader, and Late Muzzleloader Seasons must shoot their own deer and tag only the deer they shoot.

Hunters in both shotgun seasons and the November and January Antlerless-only seasons may shoot deer for each other, but each deer must be tagged within 15 minutes of the time it is killed or before it is moved whichever occurs first. A deer taken in any of these seasons will be considered in the possession of the hunter whose tag is affixed to it.

Bag and Possession Limit

For Shotgun Season 1, Shotgun Season 2, the November Antlerless-only and January Antlerless-only seasons, the daily bag and possession limit is one deer for each unfilled transportation tag issued to a hunter who is present in the party.

For all other deer seasons, the daily bag and possession limit is one deer for each license and transportation tag issued to the hunter for that season.

The annual possession limit is one deer for each license and transportation tag obtained by the hunter for all seasons.

Blaze Orange Clothing Required

To hunt deer with a firearm in any season you must wear one of the following articles of external, visible, solid blaze orange clothing: vest, jacket, coat, sweatshirt, sweater, shirt or coveralls. An orange hat alone is not sufficient.

Helping Other Hunters

Resident and nonresident deer hunters with a valid deer hunting license may hunt with and assist other deer hunters only in the season specified on their license.

Tree Stands

You may not construct a permanent tree stand on state public hunting areas. You may not drive or in any other way place any nail, spike, pin, or any other metal object into a tree on state public hunting areas to construct a blind or to provide hunting access to a location above the ground.

Tree stands may be left on a state public hunting area from 7 days prior to the start of a deer season until 7 days after the final day of that season.

Prohibited Devices and Activities

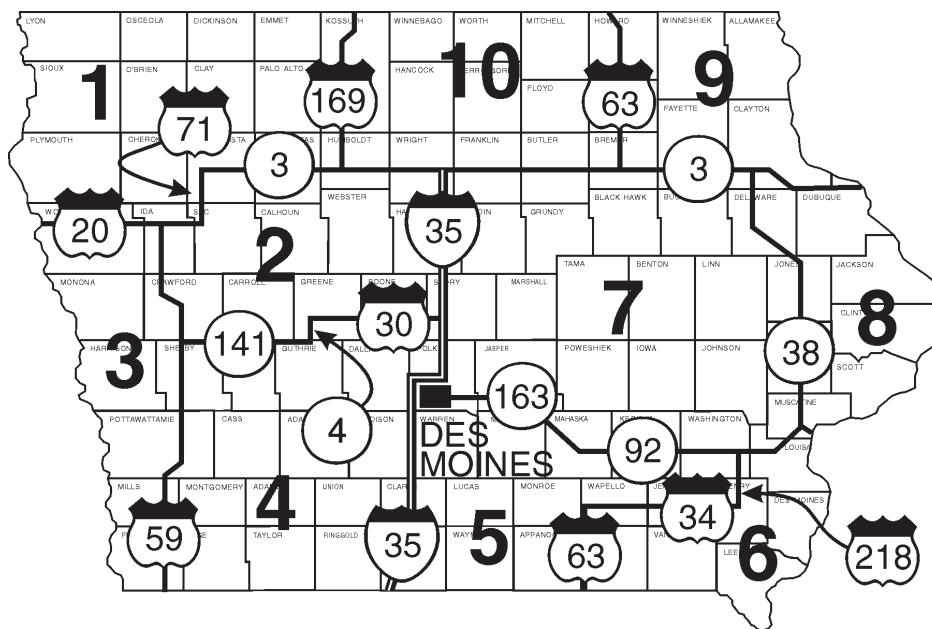
You may not use dogs, domestic animals, bait, radios, handguns, rifles and crossbows except as previously described, automobiles, aircraft, electronic calls or any mechanical conveyance or device to hunt deer. Paraplegics and single- or double-leg amputees may hunt from any stationary motor-driven conveyance. “Paraplegic” means an individual afflicted with paralysis of the lower half of the body with the involvement of both legs, usually due to disease or injury to the spinal cord.

“**Bait**” means grain, fruit, vegetables, nuts, hay, salt, mineral blocks, or any other natural food materials, commercial products containing natural food materials, or by-products of such materials transported to or placed in an area for the purpose of attracting wildlife. Bait does not include food placed during normal agricultural activities.

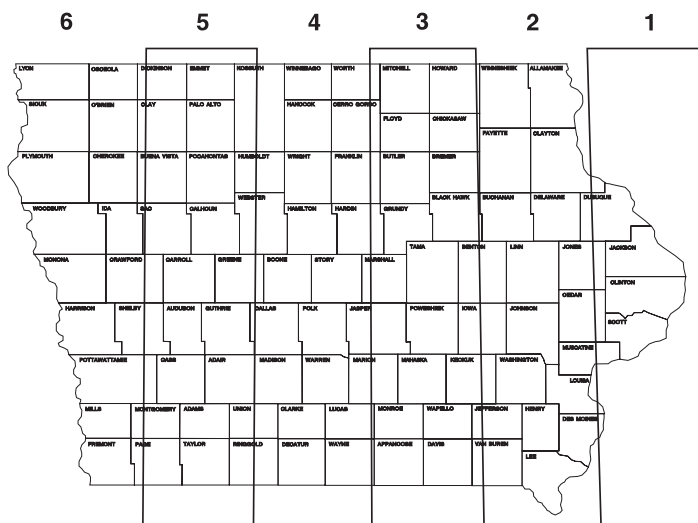
