Proof of Land Ownership: Along with this form, send us (1) a copy of your Iowa property tax statement for the current year. You may blank out the amount of your property tax if you want to keep it private. **OR** (2) provide the property address, legal description of the property, date purchased, the name of the county where the land is located and the book and page number (or instrument number) where the deed is registered. The information is available from the county government offices in the county where your property is located.

If land is owned by more than one individual or a corporation, you must also include a list of all individual owners and their home address.

*The Iowa Department of Natural Resources is required to collect social security numbers from all persons obtaining a hunting, fishing or other recreational license under section 252J.8 of the Code of Iowa and 42 U.S. Code 666(a)(13). Your social security number will serve as your principal identification number to determine your eligibility for licenses. It will be provided to law enforcement agencies and the Iowa Child Support Collection Unit to establish, modify, and enforce child support obligations. It **WILL NOT** appear on your license.

Section 483A.8, subsection 5 of the Code of Iowa: A nonresident owning land in this state may apply for one of the six thousand nonresident deer licenses and the provisions of subsection 3 shall apply. However, if a nonresident owning land in this state is unsuccessful in the drawing, the landowner shall be given preference for one of the two thousand five hundred antlerless-only nonresident deer licenses. A nonresident owning land in this state shall pay the fee for a nonresident antlerless-only deer license and the license shall be valid to hunt on the nonresident's land only. A nonresident owning land in this state is eligible for only one nonresident deer license annually. If one or more parcels of land have multiple nonresident owners, only one of the nonresident owners is eligible for a nonresident antlerless-only deer license. If a nonresident jointly owns land in this state with a resident, the nonresident shall not be given preference for a nonresident antlerless-only deer license. The department may require proof of land ownership from a nonresident landowner applying for a nonresident antlerless-only deer license.
