

Libraries: Additional Box of Masks for Protect & Disinfect Kits on the Way

Libraries, be on the lookout for an additional box of disposable masks headed your way to complete the Protect & Disinfect kits provided over the summer by the State Library via CARES Act funds. These were erroneously left out of the original kits, but the vendor agreed to rectify the mistake and provide another box of masks for every public library. The masks are being sent via IA Shares and should reach your library in the next week or two.



As with the original kits, you may use or distribute the materials at your discretion. While the intention of the kits was to help protect staff, libraries may certainly share the disinfecting products with the city department that handles cleaning the library, or hand out masks to patrons if desired. Please do **not** send the kit or materials back to the State Library for redistribution.
