E-rate Form 486 Deadline is Thursday, October 29, 2020

This is a reminder to those libraries who participate in the E-rate program for internet reimbursement, that the deadline for filing the Form 486 (which releases the funding), is tomorrow, Thursday, October 29, 2020.

Due to Covid-19 there was an adjustment in some deadlines, in addition, many libraries did not receive their FCDL in their email, which contributed to confusion on when to file the Form 486.

The USAC search tool shows that the libraries below should double check if they have filed the form 486 for FY 2020-21. If you have already done so, please disregard this reminder, as there is some delay in libraries' filing status being updated in the search tool database.
