# **Lucky Logan Farmer Wins \$1 Million**

Second-Chance Winner John Straight Surprised by Lottery Staffers

A western Iowa farmer's postal stamp paid off this morning. John Straight of Logan won the \$1 million prize in the "Thanks A Million" secondchance promotion.

"I'm shocked!" said Straight.

Straight and his wife Debbie

were surprised by Iowa Lottery representatives, friends and family early this morning at the First National Bank of Logan. The bank's vice president, Chris Hartwig, helped arrange the surprise.

"I told John that I had some old pictures to share with him and since he's a history buff, I thought it would get his attention," said Hartwig.

The lottery also talked with various relatives in town to make sure Straight would be in town for the celebration.

The Iowa Lottery's Money Mobile rolled into town and set up an hour before the check presentation so the Straights would not be suspicious of all the activity. The couple was supposed to show up at 9 a.m., but called to say they were delayed for an hour.

"The cows got out [on the farm] and we had to get them back in," said Debbie Straight. The Straights also thought they would have to skip the meeting altogether to pick up boars in

### **Clip and Post!**

Dream'n of Dollars — Top Prize \$12,000

Pot Luck — Top Prize \$400

Be sure that players know the top prizes on the lottery's newest scratch tickets, "Dream'n of Dollars" (top prize is \$12,000) and "Pot Luck" (top prize is \$400). Since the top prize amounts are not on these tickets, players may ask you about them. Please post this notice on or near your scratch ticket dispenser so all clerks can see it. You may also tell them they can find this information in the game brochure. Thank you!

#### **Check For Credit Versus Debit Cards**

Remember that there's a big difference between a debit card and a credit card — even though they may look the same. Many banks offer their customers debit cards that can be used to withdraw money from their checking or savings account. Plus some cards are combination credit cards and debit cards. If a lottery player hands you a card, it's important that you ask the player which kind of card they are using before you make the transaction. Lottery players can use debit cards to purchase lottery products. However, state law prohibits the use of credit cards to make a lottery purchase.

#### Mason City Man Wins Two \$10,000 Prizes in Two Days

in Mason City, but it wasn't

long before he was back.

Luck struck twice for one northern Iowa man. He now has \$20,000 thanks to his good fortune.

On Jan. 24, 2006, Michael Eppens of Mason City won the top prize of \$10,000 playing

the "Super Diamond Vault" TouchPlay game. He played and won at Kum & Go, 2301 S. Federal in Mason City.

The next day, Eppens took the day off from work to claim his prize at the Iowa Lottery's regional office in Mason City, but it wasn't long before he was back.

Eppens said, "I had some time to kill, about 10 minutes before picking up my kids." Eppens stopped by the Kum & Go at 1465 Fourth St. S.E. in Mason City to grab a drink. While he was there, he put some money in the "Super Diamond Vault" TouchPlay game and won the \$10,000 top prize again!

"I couldn't believe it. [It's] pretty unbelievable," Eppens said. "[My wife] had to talk with the lottery people be-

cause she didn't believe me!"

Eppens, 38, works as a supervisor for a door manufacturing company. "My co-workers all expect me to buy lunch now," he said. However, Eppens has other plans for his winnings. He

wants to help pay off his wife's education, buy his two kids a computer and MP3 player, take his family to Walt Disney World and put the rest in the bank.

Customers insert money into a Touch-Play machine as they do with any other vending machine. When a play is made, the TouchPlay machine's video monitor displays the results of the play while

electronic tones indicate whether the play has won a prize.

The overall odds of winning in the Super Diamond Vault game are 1 in 3. Prizes of \$2 to \$400 are claimed at the retailer. Prizes worth \$2,000 or \$10,000 are claimed at any Iowa Lottery office.

Thanks A Million was a \$10 instant-scratch ticket that was released last summer to celebrate the Iowa Lottery's 20th Anniversary. The Thanks A Million ticket was created to thank players for their continuous support. The top prize in the game was \$10,000, however nonwinning Thanks A Million tickets could be entered for a chance to win up to \$1 million. The top prize drawing was held Jan. 26.
