Gov. Reynolds Announces COVID-19 Arts & Cultural Recovery Program

Gov. Kim Reynolds has allocated \$7 million of federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act funding to the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs to [provide economic relief](#) to Iowa's arts and culture industry.

The Iowa Arts & Cultural Recovery Program will be administered by the Iowa Arts Council and the State Historical Society of Iowa, divisions of the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs.

Nonprofit arts and cultural organizations, for-profit music venues, governmental and college/university cultural venues, and individual artists whose regular operations have been interrupted due to the pandemic may apply until **Dec. 11, 2020**.
