RE: Registered Flexible Fuel Vehicles

Iowa Code section 452A.33(3) requires by February 1 of each year the Iowa Department of Transportation shall deliver a report to the governor and legislative services agency regarding flexible fuel vehicles registered in Iowa. The report shall include:

1. the number of flexible fuel vehicles according to year of manufacture;
2. the number of passenger vehicles according to the year of manufacture; and
3. the number of light pickup trucks according to the year of manufacture.
