

for want of more rooms; while the corps of instructors, the various appliances and apparatus, are amply sufficient for more than twice the number. There are some twenty professors and teachers whose labors would be but little increased with twice the number of students; and they would require increased accommodations, to be provided for only from the state treasury.

The college has ample funds, but it is restricted in the use of them by the conditions of the grant, not being permitted to use them for buildings and fixtures, but for instruction, the library, and needful apparatus. If any arrangement can be made by which the funds on hand belonging to the college can be used for the purpose, your committee would recommend an appropriation for the enlargement of accommodations for students.

The endowment fund is a rich heritage, yielding an income already more than sufficient to pay for all instruction and incidental expenses connected therewith, and if this fund is properly cared for, the income amply sufficient already, will be very largely increased, if not doubled—so that the question of establishing other similar schools may soon have to be considered.

In conclusion, your committee are satisfied that the aim and intent of the institution is a good one. Young men and young women will here find the means of qualifying themselves for usefulness in life, and usefulness in life should mean, and does mean with all sensible people, respectability in life. It may not be amiss to caution the community not to be too impatient in expecting speedy results. It requires time, and labor, and thought to develop a harmonious and well balanced working system when there are such various conditions and requirements to be considered. But your committee believe that such an end will soon be reached, and the agricultural college be classed among the valued institutions of the state.
