Nore—Unier Chapter 15t, Section 8, laws of 155, there were Warrants issued to Counties to the amount of \$15,01260—of which \$1217060 has been red-emed by the State Treasurer and cancelled at settlement. Of the excess of School Fund interest in the counties and State interest on home, there has been paid \$55,000.43. Hence the account shows a balance in the Treasury of \$15,913.75, greater than the tree Revenue balance. The amount of such Warrants and excesses will just balance when all shall be paid in, as such Warrants still in the hands of the County Treasurer, exceed the excesses the above amount, \$16,913.75.
