

Iowa handcrafting folk artists who are actively producing work and sustaining cultural traditions are invited to [apply for a two-day, online workshop](#) presented by the Iowa Arts Council in partnership with the Vesterheim Folk Art School in Decorah, with support from the National Endowment for the Arts. Participating artists will have a chance to share ideas and learn best practices to engage new audiences through online demonstration videos and at-home kits.


