## LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL.

---

*Hon. Leslie M. Shaw, Governor of Iowa:*

DEAR SIR—In compliance with the provisions of section 2510, chapter 11, title XII of the code of 1897, I have the honor to transmit herewith a report of all the inspections made by the oil inspectors, and the receipts and expenditures therefor, during the biennial period ending June 30, 1899.

It is a pleasure to be able to report that this biennial period has been the most profitable one to the state in the history of the inspection service. The receipts from inspections exceeded those of the best previous period by \$12,000, and the amount turned over to the Treasurer of State, after deducting the salary of the State Oil Inspector, exceeded that of the best previous period by nearly \$7,000.

During the last year of this period, the law doing away with the office of State Oil Inspector, and dividing the state into districts and providing for the appointment of oil inspectors for each district, was operative. This provision of the statutes has resulted in an annual saving to the state of \$2,900, the amount of salary and expenses of the State Oil Inspector, and has not in any way impaired the efficiency of the inspection service. Indeed, this service is now in excellent condition; this being largely due to the fact that the inspectors have at all times been most faithful and energetic in the performance of every duty.

In accordance with the provisions of chapter 52 of the acts of the Twenty-seventh General Assembly, relative to the adulteration of linseed or flax seed oil, I have caused to be collected by the various inspectors during the past year something over 100 samples of linseed oil, and have turned the same over to the State Board of Health for analysis. As a result of that analysis some of the samples of oil were found to be adulterated, and the inspectors have been directed by the State Board of Health to prosecute parties selling and manufacturing these impure oils. Several such cases are now pending in the district courts of the state.
