AN ACT OF CONGRESS CONFIRMING THE TITLE TO CERTAIN LANDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America is Congress Assembled, That the title to the land certified to the State of Iowa by the commissioners of the general land office of the United States, under an act of Congress entitled "An act confirming a land claim in the State of Iowa, and for other purposes," approved July Twelve, Eighteen hundred and sixty-two, in accordance with the adjustment made by the authorized agent of the State of Iowa and the commissioner of the general land office, on the twenty-first day of May, anno. Domini eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the twenty-second day of May, Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and approved by the Secretary of the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, approved March thirty-one, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and approved March thirty-one, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed to the State of Iowa, and its grantees in accordance with said adjustment and said act of the General Assembly of the State of Iowa.

Provided, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to effect adversely any existing legal rights or the rights of any party claiming title or the right to acquire title to any part of said lands under the provisions of the so-called homestead or pre-empted laws of the United States, claiming any part thereof as swamp lands.

LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL

STATE OF IOWA, Office of Secretary of State,

Des Moines, Iowa, November 21, 1908.

To his Excellency, Albert B. Cummins, Governor of the State of Iowa:

Sir,—In compliance with the provisions of section sixty-nine of the code I have the honor herewith to report an abstract of the criminal prosecutions in the several counties of the state for the biennial period ending September 30, 1908, as returned to this office by the clerks of the district courts.

The thirty-second general assembly by an act approved April 2, 1907, and known as chapter one hundred ninety-two, acts of the thirty-second general assembly, provided for the appointment of a board of parole, designated the penitentiary at Anamosa to be a reformatory, and inaugurated the system of indeterminate sentences for all persons sentenced to the penitentiary or reformatory except for treason or murder. Under this act the clerks of the district courts are required to furnish the board of parole with a copy of the indictment, with the minutes of the testimony attached thereto, and other information concerning all commitments to the penitentiary or reformatory. Under this law nearly all the information now reported to this office by the clerks of the district courts under the provisions of section two hundred ninety-three of the code is also received by the board of parole.

In all convictions of felons, except for treason or murder, the board of parole determines what portion of the maximum term imposed by the statute shall be served by the convict. Under this provision it is impossible for the clerks of the district courts to report to this office the term of punishment served by those convicted of felonies. This information can only be obtained of the board of parole. In view of the foregoing and for the further reason that the law creating the board of parole makes no provision for a report of its doings I would recommend that section sixty-nine of the code be so amended that the report of the criminal prosecutions of the state to the governor be made by the board of parole and that section two hundred ninety-three of the code be so amended as to require the clerks of the district courts to report to that board such information as is necessary to enable it to make a full report of all convictions for felonies and misdemeanors.

I would also recommend that the criminal report year begin July 1st and end June 30th, so as to conform with the fiscal year of the state.
