"Sapient_2.021" is an experimental short film that combines dance, robotics and visual art to explore labor, control, empathy and humanity in the tech-saturated world. With support from Des Moines Performing Arts, **Iowa Artist Fellow Amenda Tate's sci-fi-inspired production** features her motion-controlled painting robot "Manibus," which translates dance into paintings that represent life in the wake of 2020.
