## REPORT.

---

To the HONORABLE JOHN W. AKERS, State Superintendent of Public Instruction:

SIR—The Regents of the State University of Iowa herewith present their biennial report for the two years succeeding their last report.

The report of the President, herewith submitted, shows the following summary of students for the biennial period:

The report of the President calls the attention of the Board to pressing wants of the Institution, and we beg to emphasize the suggestions of the President in those respects:

*First.* A chemical laboratory building fitted with the modern appliances, and affording room and light for the best exercise of the labors of students.

*Second.* A hospital building as an adjunct and aid to the best work of the Medical Department, as well as for affording to the afflicted and needy citizens of the State services of the medical faculty, which in such cases are given to these people with the minimum of expense for medicines, thus affording at once to them skilled and expert treatment, and to the class of the Medical Department, opportunity of practical demonstration in the several departments of their work.

*Third.* The Homeopathic Medical Department is steadily growing. It meets the views as to medical treatment of a large and respectable number of the citizens of the State, and its wants and needs should be recognized with those of other departments. The building now devoted to the uses of that department is inadequate and affords no proper means and facilities for the best exercise of the labors of the faculty or of the students therein engaged.

*Fourth.* A gymnasium and field for athletic sports. All institutions of learning in this age are recognizing the necessity of sustaining during college work, the physical as well as the mental strength. And to this end all well regulated institutions have taken pains to supply, for the use of the students, gymnasiums and opportunities for field exercises and sports.

*Fifth.* The board has, from time to time, deemed it proper, especially when opportunity was afforded to do so at a minimum of cost, to enlarge and add to the museum of natural history. In this way there has been secured at very small comparative cost valuable specimens in that department. These specimens require protection under glass, for the exclusion of insects and the like, and cases for that purpose are sadly needed.

*Sixth.* It is more and more coming to be appreciated and understood that with all the text books and the instruction of teachers, the practical work-room of an institution of this kind in all its departments is the library. And while we have devoted from the appropriation heretofore made by the legislature, from year to year, as much money as could be spared in this direction, the amounts after all have

been, when compared with the value of the library as a place of effective work, entirely too meager for the demands.

In the State institutions of neighboring States the value of this department has been recognized most liberally, and to that end large and commodious buildings have been erected by the State, and those buildings stocked with large, efficient and valuable libraries, useful in all the departments.

We believe it is true that the legislature of Iowa has never yet, specially, recognized in its appropriations the library of its State University.

*Seventh.* Repairs are needed upon all of the buildings, except the one last erected, as also upon the fences and other appurtenances.

We earnestly join the recommendation of the President in these regards.

From the report of the Treasurer, hereto attached, you will find the financial exhibit from the date of the last Treasurer's report found in the report of the State University, as follows:

It may be added from the Treasurer's report that the total working capital, that is the permanent fund, appears to be \$215,036.53.

Since the last biennial report a committee of the Board, of which the Governor of the State was chairman, made an exhaustive examination of the Treasurer's books, the result of which was to verify the correctness of the accounts kept by the Treasurer, and to disclose the very gratifying condition of the permanent fund, there being a very small amount comparatively of all the numerous contracts running over a long period of years, considered valueless. The above estimate of working capital does not include, of course, unsold lands, which were estimated at the date of the last report to be worth \$15,000.00. There have been, as appears from the report, some sales since that time, the effect of which is shown in the increase of the permanent fund, after deducting notes supposed by the committee who made the aforesaid examination, to be worthless.

The following from the action taken by the Board with reference to the regular work and appropriations, for the year commencing June, 1887, and ending June, 1888, may be of interest and a guide to yourself and the legislature, as indicating the standing of the Institution financially for the year now in progress and the probable standing for the next year.

It is to be observed that the period covered by the action of the Board commences at a slightly different date from that which marks the expiration of the period covered by the Treasurer's report. And it is also to be noticed that it necessarily occurs that at the date of the closing of the Treasurer's report there are outstanding warrants drawn by the Secretary not yet presented to and paid by the Treasurer, and obligations incurred for which warrants have not been issued. These outstanding warrants and obligations incurred necessarily make a difference between the amount reported by the Treasurer to be on hand and the amount known by the Board through the Secretary's books to be at its disposal.

The aggregate of the appropriations in June and September apparently exceed the estimated income by the sum of \$545.10. But it is to be observed that several of the regular chairs have not been filled, and therefore the amounts appropriated to them are not being expended. It is also to be noticed that when those chairs shall be filled, the assistants employed for the reason that they are not filled, will be dispensed with. The Board, therefore, expects that there will be, unless unexpected demands shall arise, a small balance unexpended at the first half of the next biennial period.

In closing this report, we respectfully desire to urge, in addition to what has already been said in connection with the President's report, that you shall deem it proper to urge upon the legislature the need of increased assistance to the University, in addition to special appropriations for buildings, and the like, to the end that the Board of Regents may be able to secure the best available talent in the several departments. The University is an institution created, and

heretofore with reasonable liberality sustained, by the State. It is to be said, however, that institutions of a similar character in our neighboring States have already realized that to make themselves equal to the great work of thorough education, they must have and retain in the different chairs of the institution, men of advanced education, thorough training and broad requirements. To secure such men requires, as it does in every other department of work, salaries equal to their ability. We cannot hope to build up and maintain a successful university, especially in competition with other universities and colleges of large endowment, without placing our own upon an equality in these respects with such institutions. It should be the ambition, as well as the pride of Iowa, already in the advance in educational statistics, to attain and keep an advanced position with its highest school of learning. The University, as you well know, is the head of the school system of the State. With common schools equal to the best, we should not fall behind with the University. To keep at the head requires money, and money, too, that cannot better be expended for the moral and material welfare of the State.

You will not overlook the fact that in the foregoing statement of funds at our disposal, we have had the appropriation of chapter 68, Laws of Twenty-first General Assembly, and those sums have been essential to meet the demands of the Institution, meet them as economically as we could.

Among the pressing needs of the University which I beg to bring to your attention are the following:

1. A chemical laboratory building. This seems to be of all things the one which is most necessary. Instruction in chemistry is given to students in all of the departments except that of law, and the capacity of the present quarters is altogether inadequate for the members requiring such instruction. At a recent meeting of the University senate, in which all departments are represented, it was unanimously resolved that the Board of Regents should be requested to lay the matter of a new chemical laboratory before the legislature as one of the most pressing importance. The subject of chemistry is every year receiving more and more attention, and in order to bring our facilities for instruction up to the proper point it is absolutely necessary that the State should supply its University with a commodious and well-equipped laboratory.

2. For many reasons it is highly desirable that the University should at an early day be provided with a well-appointed, modern hospital. The building now used for the purpose is old, inconvenient, ill-equipped, and in many respects insufficient for the needs of the medical department. The erection of a new hospital would not only increase the facilities afforded the medical student, but would also insure to the benefit of the people of the State by supplying them with a place where patients from all parts could receive medical and surgical treatment in cases of severe illness or injury.

3. For the development of the homeopathic medical department it is highly desirable that more ample and better quarters should be secured, and it gives me great pleasure to endorse the petition of the State Homeopathic Medical Association, and of the faculty of the department, for an appropriation of \$30,000 for the erection and equipment of a new building.

4. A gymnasium and field for athletic sports. The experience of other institutions has shown that money spent for such purposes is not by any means wasted, but that an investment in this direction pays for itself many times over in the increased vigor and improved health of the students. They are by no means to be regarded as luxuries, but rather as necessary to the development of the physical well-being of the youth who are committed to our care. A very moderate outlay would supply us with all that is necessary for this purpose, and it is earnestly hoped that a special appropriation may be granted therefor.

5. Additional cases are required in the museum, for the preservation of the specimens of natural history. The excellent collection already on hand should not be allowed to suffer from exposure to dust and handling by visitors.

6. So far as the money at command has permitted the general library of the University has not been neglected, and upon the whole it can fairly be claimed that, for the number of books, it is an excellent collection. Nevertheless it is true that there is great need of considerable additions. In this matter every professor and every student is directly interested, and for the sake of the whole body I respectfully ask that some measures be taken to provide for the purchase of a large number of books which are every day becoming more and more indispensable.

7. The medical building is sadly in need of repairs. In fact its appearance suggests the idea that it never was entirely completed. If allowed to continue in its present condition the time will soon come when the cost of repairs will be far greater than if the matter is attended to at once.

Repairs are also needed on all of the older buildings belonging to the Institution, though fortunately not to so great an extent as in the case of the medical building. A new fence around the campus would not only very materially improve the appearance of the grounds, but seems to me to be necessary in consideration of the very irregular and battered state of the present one.

It is poor economy to allow the condition of the property to run down, and I respectfully beg that these matters may receive your early attention.

All of which is very respectfully submitted.
