This table shows the aggregate assessed value and the average assessed value per mile of the railroad property of this state, as fixed by the executive council on the first Monday in March or the second Monday of July of the respective years named in the left hand column. The items, "miles of road" and "gross earnings," shown in connection with each year's assessment, are for the year ending on the 31st day of December last year, likewise of net earnings.

^aThis amount is based on the average number of miles of road operated within this state for the entire year ending December 31st of the year preceding.

Note.—The taxes paid are always paid on the mileage reported two years prior to the date the taxes are reported to the executive council e. g., the tax reported in 1906 was levied on 9,799,6363 miles of road, that being the mileage reported and assessed in 1904, and the taxes were paid in 1905. Hence, in determining the amount of taxes paid per mile, it is necessary to use the mileage reported two years prior to the year in which the taxes were reported to the executive council. In determining the per cent of tax on gross and net earnings, it is necessary to take earnings of preceding year.
