REPORT OF FISH AND GAME DEPARTMENT

JULY 1, 1922 TO JUNE 30, 1924

The department of fish and game, whether in this state or any other, at this period of our country's history presents a field wide and fascinating to a degree. The management of such a department is naturally and logically brought in contact with sets of conditions almost endless in their variety and ramifications. These come with a challenge which the intelligent and forward-looking mind can neither side-track nor avoid.

Fish and game includes the habitat and environment of finny, feathery and furry creatures. In the fish leaping into the sunlight and the bird breaking cover, we see the clear, purling stream, the placid lake, the marsh wondrously adapted to its specific forms of life, the underbrush in whose friendly shade the warbler and the timid mammal hide, the wooded height guarded by growths of a century or more, where the soil is secure and the refreshing rains from the skies are wisely retarded in their further flow.

And while we see all these, we hear the magical concert and symphony of out-door voices, ever attuned to the welfare and delight of man, a harmony and unity prevailing that man only can disturb. But man has disturbed it sadly, and thus a process is demanded which shall meet the dire situation, and, as far as possible, restore what prevailed when our country was far less densely populated than now.

To the claims of conservation of the out-doors the State Fish and Game Department will respond, and to the best of its ability meet the requirements of its natural and logical field, while appealing to every dweller of our beautiful and nationally known progressive state to co-operate with it first, last, and all the time.

Alarm voices have long been sounding in our land as to the devastation of its wild life of every kind, but of late these voices have become more clarion-like in their note, more insistent in their demand. Commercial greed and personal selfishness are having a mighty clash with the forces of law and order, the words here being used in their best and most truly normal sense. The marvelously lovely framework and setting of our outdoor America has been indelibly scarred and the ruthless agency is

industriously functioning. And as every state through its fish and game department, or similar organization, should respond to its duty and inherent destiny here, so we of Iowa will shoulder our burden and respond "Aye" to the call.

As is so well known, Iowa has a super broad area of land, easily accessible to cultivation, practically the whole of its fertile surface coming under the domination of the plow and seed-drill, and yielding a rich return in the crops that follow in their train. But a state that has nothing but fertile soil is poorly off indeed. Water is required, swamp is required, rock is required, hill and dell required, in addition to these. Not only are what we have enumerated required to minister to man's happiness in the higher realm of being, paramount in importance, but they are necessary and absolutely so, when it comes to man's needs as an animal in the matter of being fed and clothed.

And our efforts should function to the protection of Iowa's lakes, streams, marshes and woodlands, preserving these, as far as possible, as we have received them from the Creator's hands, and we thus enjoy the full benefit they were intended to convey. It is perfectly legitimate to drain certain wet lands in the interest of agriculture, as on a rare occasion it may be demonstrated that it is wise to straighten a stream, but the last named should never be done, apart from careful investigation and study, always bearing in mind the over preponderance of land that Iowa possesses of cultivable kind.

This report outlines certain data of the two years ending June 30, 1924, these generally dealing with the issuing of licenses of varying kind, records of law-breaking, and financial tables. As will be noted relative to the last named, not a cent is drawn from the tax-payer's pocket, as the department runs under its own power all the time.

The general character of this report is true to the trend of the past, but with new conditions and a broadening vision, as already indicated, we shall, as we proceed in detail, give effect to suggestions and recommendations to which we invite the respectful attention of our readers, and then co-operation as opportunity offers.

Among many subjects having special significance are the following:

THE AGRICULTURISTS OF IOWA

We are glad to recognize and reciprocate the valued aid the farmers of our state contribute to the great enterprise for which

the department stands. This assistance, we feel, will be multiplied and accelerated when our agricultural friends realize how much more can be done by complying more sympathetically with nature's own ways and restoring as far as possible what we have suffered the past to take from us.

The call is imperative that we increase very largely the number of our insectivorous and other birds. Can anything surpass in beauty and wonder of appeal what a spring day in Iowa reveals, when fresh from the southland appear regiments of tiny aviators, arrayed in their own distinctive uniform, that declare themselves the farmer's active and efficient aids? They get to work without delay, they labor diligently, they do not loaf, their little families fatten on the carcasses of the farmer's enemies, and though these enemies are, in many cases, very small, their infinite numbers represent a menace that strong language only can adequately express.

With such an effective illustration as this, we have a clear demonstration that the need is more than urgent for a far, far greater number of these wonderfully helpful feathered police. And the farmer, as the supervisor and custodian of the broad, fertile acres of Iowa, is the one to promote this necessary and imperative movement. An essential step in bringing this about is the cultivation of cover and underbrush.

To advocate an increase of cover may seem to be stepping backward, but while it is logically this, in all that is really progressive it indicates a going forward. If we would retain and increase the invaluable labors of our little insect and weed seed warriors, we must provide for their lodging. We must forever relinquish the idea of what is known as "cleaning up" everywhere. A prime appearance, where all rough places are made smooth, bunches of thorn and bramble eliminated, all underbrush shaved away and the moisture of the swamp removed, may respond to a certain idea of neatness, but is bad scientific farming and will bar the way to giving us increased efficiency in nature's own plan for the protection of our crops, the splendid militant labors of the birds of the air.

If the plea be made, that to allow a certain area of farm land to revert to wild growth, would be to reduce the acreage of cultivated fruits, the answer is forthcoming that the amount of this would be negligible, and much more than made up in the benefit accruing from the carrying out of the principles of farming according to nature's plan, which in the last analysis must

inevitably stand as the best. Would it not be a change for the better to have more bird helpers and less expenditures for Paris green and similar preparations, with the unpleasantness associated with their use? And the increase of cover so necessary for bird life could no doubt be brought about by the cultivation of certain growth which would secure this in addition to being of economic value.

OUR LOYAL SPORTSMEN

The department much appreciates the helpful and growing interest manifested by the sportsmen of Iowa, indicating an increasing all around co-operation among the men and women, who would like to see the out-door cover of our state much more populous with game birds, and its streams and lakes more numerously tenanted with game fish.

The constantly increasing numbers of fish and game clubs in our state is an index to a healthy prevailing sentiment for fish and game conservation, and the department seeks close and sympathetic co-ordination with these clubs and all similar movements, that by common organized effort the best results may be attained for the cause in which we are severally interested.

WOBBLING JUSTICES OF THE PEACE

A situation calling for concerted endeavor is that of a locality where law enforcement is difficult, and where, after our deputies have labored hard and intelligently to secure convictions, these efforts have been rendered abortive through a lack of healthy, public spirit, and the loose and wobbling attitude of some of the justices of the peace presiding at the trials. We feel that where such a situation exists, (and we are afraid that it is all too common) most valuable aid can be rendered by the law-abiding citizens of such a community, and the local fish and game clubs would appear to be the strategic avenue through which this aid will come in its most effective and forceful way. Such co-operation will also assist in interpreting the status of our deputy game wardens. These men represent a state department second to none in intrinsic importance and no effort will be spared on our part to supply our various centers and districts with men whom the local community will respect and support.

THE POLLUTION OF OUR LAKES AND STREAMS

The department wishes to place itself on record as favoring the most drastic action for antagonizing the pollution of our lakes and streams. Simply because it is convenient to turn the

refuse of our cities and industrial plants into our public waters is no valid reason why it should be done, and no reason why these waters should not be as pure as the air we breathe. There are streams in the east of our country that are open sewers of filth. Do we wish a similar situation in a state that, as yet, is largely not in such a category? If not, then we should lose no time whatever in fighting to the limit any further advance of the stream pollution menace of the east. That it is with us, all those who witnessed a number of dead and dying fish on February 1st last, in the Shell Rock river near Greene, can abundantly testify. This was one of the revelations arising from the public enquiry instituted as to the conditions of the river, in response to the appeal of the Greene residents.

The excuse put forward for permitting stream pollution will be that it is in the interest of "Big Business," but that is by no means justifiable. Big business is not the biggest thing after all and moreover in the very nature of things should be big enough to care for its own waste, and if it cannot do this, there must be a screw loose somewhere. The really big thing is to keep the wonderful out-of-doors, with every legitimate provision and change for human need, as the Creator designed it, and thus shall we secure all that is best in human happiness and welfare.

A stream should never be straightened, unless the reasons advanced for such bear the marks of extreme and imperative need. A winding stream as nature made it provides nooks and crannies and corners where the fish can live their own home life, deposit their spawn and protect their progeny. And then the winding course retards the river's flow, as nature would have it and have it for the best. A straightened stream is merely an open drain, for the beauty of the original has gone, and beauty is also an economic asset. The course of no stream should be altered, unless passed on by a body of men competent to deal with the situation from the standpoint of education and experience.

THE RING-NECK PHEASANT

Through the activities of the state game farm and the subsequent initial distribution of the bird throughout Iowa, its numbers have greatly increased, particularly in some sections, indicating that it finds our territory suited to its needs and that it is becoming well acclimatized.

In some counties where this pheasant has become fairly numerous, complaints have been made of its preying on the farmer's

crops and to some extent this may be true, though doubtless such stories have often been exaggerated.

During the term of the 1923-24 legislature, the department favored a small bag limit of the male ring-necks in sections where the birds were most numerous, but the law-makers of the state did not think that the time had arrived for this. As the bird further multiplies, proper steps will be taken to regulate this in the interest of all concerned and the subject receive the consideration warranted by its importance. The ring-neck is a fine large and handsome bird, on the one hand adding to the picturesque character of our fields and cover, and on the other representing a food factor of considerable value.

THE DEPUTY WARDEN

The ever enlarging area of activity and service for which the department stands, naturally means that the deputy wardens located through the state inherit a responsibility increasing in similar ratio. The added importance to the duties of these many helpers, tends to draw the best from them in the discharge of such duties, and we invite the co-operation of Iowa residents everywhere in lining up with our men, particularly where a situation may develop a delicate and difficult angle. No post in the state is more honorable than that connected with our work, and we trust our citizens generally will recognize this. We hope that before long every county in Iowa will have its deputy game warden, to whom every wild life lover can look for support in the mutual cause, and who in return will heartily reciprocate such action. This will pave the way for greater and better things still.

THE FISH OF LAKE OKOBOJI

Among the outdoor gems of Iowa, and in fact of the central west, is the West Okoboji Lake, with its deep blue waters and wooded environment. The July-September, 1923, number of the magazine, Iowa Conservation, contains an attractive outline of work done by Dr. L. H. Tiffany of the University of Ohio, during the summer of 1923, in the study of the algae of this lake, aquatic plants on which fish live extensively. The article is from the pen of Dr. Robert B. Wylie of the State University of Iowa, Director of the Lakeside Laboratory, Okoboji, where year by year research work is carried out in the interest of biology.

After a general survey of what has been going forward for a number of years in connection with a study of this

lake, and specifically of its plant life, Dr. Wylie reports on the co-operation received from the State Fish and Game Department in securing Dr. Tiffany for this work, at the same time paying an interesting tribute to the latter in what he had accomplished in revealing conditions having an important bearing on the welfare of the various species of fish that live in the lake.

The department is more than glad to assist in progressive scientific and economic advance such as this, and will welcome all such opportunities, commensurate with its natural limitations, from whatever part of the state they may come.

WILD RICE

The introduction of wild rice throughout the state has been a helpful factor in promoting the increase of duck visitors. The plant is not native to Iowa, but readily grows here. Wild ducks are fond of it, and the number of stopping places for ducks can be increased by planting it in suitable locations. The department will be glad to furnish seed rice to persons in the state applying for it, and who will see that it is properly planted and cared for.

During the first year of this biennium the department purchased and distributed throughout the state 1,120 pounds of wild rice seed, and during the second year, 1,950 pounds.

FISH RESCUE WORK

In the early part of the year, due to spring rains and melting snow, most of the rivers of the state rise so much that low-lying areas along their banks are flooded. Fish spawn and feed in the quiet waters thus formed, and, later in the summer, are trapped in the land-locked ponds and sloughs which are formed when the rivers recede to their normal levels.

Deputy wardens are equipped with rescue seines for seining out and returning to live waters the fish thus trapped. During the year ending June 30, 1923, deputy wardens, assisted by fish and game clubs, rescued 636,700 fish and placed them in running waters, while for the following year, 2,269,000 were rescued.

Along the Mississippi River this work is carried on by crews working out from the Sabula and Lansing collecting stations. Thousands of fish are rescued annually and released to the main channel of the river, while some of small size, suitable for transportation, are collected and conveyed to the stations for distribution throughout the state. The distributions of fish, collected at these stations for this biennium, were as follows:



REPORT ON REMOVAL OF ROUGH FISH

Unless properly controlled, rough fish propagate so rapidly that they become detrimental to the propagation of game fish. For this reason the law provides that the warden may enter into contracts with commercial fishermen for the removal of carp, buffalo, and other rough fish, from any state waters. The work of each contract is done under personal supervision of a deputy game warden, and all expenses connected with each contract are borne by the fishermen with whom the contract is made. In addition to reducing the rough fish menace, this method provides considerable revenue for the state.

MUSSELS

Early in 1923, after conferences with representatives of Illinois, Wisconsin and the U. S. Bureau of Fisheries, certain areas of the Mississippi River were closed to the taking of mussels for a period of five years. Illinois and Wisconsin closed the areas directly opposite those closed by Iowa, so that each area extends from shore to shore.

Areas of rivers that have been closed to clamming and which are in effect at this time are:

Des Moines River closed from the mouth to Eddyville and from Des Moines to Ft. Dodge, until January 1, 1926.

Iowa River closed from the mouth to Marengo and from Marshalltown to Iowa Falls, until January 1, 1926.

Cedar River closed from Cedar Rapids up throughout its headwaters, until January 1, 1926.

Shell Rock River entirely closed, until January 1, 1926.

Smith Creek in Muscatine County entirely closed, until January 1, 1926.

Mississippi River closed from Lansing to Harper's Ferry; from Marquette to Guttenberg; from Specht's Ferry to Dubuque; from Bellevue to Sabula; from Clinton to the mouth of the Wapsipinicon River; from Bettendorf to Buffalo; from Muscatine to Port Louisa; from New Boston, Illinois, to Keithsburg, Illinois; and from Oquawka, Illinois, to Burlington, until January 1, 1928.







OUT OF DOOR NOTES AND MAXIMS

Be Generous

When hunting, never make undue effort to reach the bag limit. What the law allows is invariably too large, so be generous in the use of your privilege.

Be a Good Sport

In both hunting and fishing be true to the ethics of good sport, always rely on your skill in such a way that the weaker creature has a chance.

Help the Deputy

Be the deputy warden's ready supporter when occasion requires, and thus promote what will tend to the mutual welfare of all lovers of the out-of-doors. This will create a standard of conduct that will minister to the good will of all.

Watch for the Quail

When the snow is drifting and the ground is frozen near where we live, there may be a covey of quail unable to get any food. It will save the birds and do us lots of good if we sweep away the snow and scatter grain and table scraps where they can feed on them.

The Air Gun

This instrument is of no practical value and in the hands of an inexperienced person may become a dangerous weapon. Parents should never permit the air gun in the home, and thus save the lads from the temptation to use it and avoid the accidents that so easily come.

Birds Like Water

Water is a vital necessity for our birds and many species use it for bathing as well as drinking. Every garden should have a vessel a few feet square and an inch or two deep, where the robins, goldfinches and others can come and drink or bathe as they may wish. Place this where it will be safe from cats and other enemies of birds.
