In addition to last week being the first funnel, the Health and Human Services appropriation bill also was released by the House. [HSB 764](#), which will come before the full House Appropriations Committee on Tuesday, March 7th at 3pm.

The House Health and Human Services Appropriations Bill

The bill appropriates \$3,627,645 in General Fund appropriations for the menu of programs outlined in federal and state code. The budget does provide \$750,000 in new General Fund dollars to be used for the Case Management Program for Frail Elders (this is 2,250,000 less than the Governor's budget of \$3,000,000), and caps provider reimbursement for ongoing case management at \$70.00 per client per month. The budget also provides \$25,000 new dollars to the Department for the training of Area Agency on Aging board members and provides an increase of \$26,000 to the Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP). Within the Senior Living Trust, the bill appropriates \$8,296,730. Of these dollars, \$2,196,967 are appropriated to be used for the CMPFE. The bill requires that the DEA transfer \$1,010,000 of Senior Living Program funds to the Department of Human Services to be used as match to draw down Medicaid Funds for CMPFE. The bill also

includes intent language which increases the projected number of new individuals served in the program to 1,650 (up 1,000 from the Department's projections of 650).

DEA's Response:

We are grateful that the sub-committee agrees that more resources are needed in CMPFE to meet the obligations of making it a covered service within the Title XIX HCBS Elderly Waiver. We continue to believe, however, that our original budget offer which was included in the Governor's budget was an accurate assessment of the need for additional resources. This includes, an additional 1.0 FTE in DEA to analyze the information related to CMPFE as a Medicaid service. The group which developed this proposal included representatives from DHS, the Area Agencies on Aging and DEA, which have extensive experience and expertise with CMS and CMPFE. We look forward to working with LSA and the Legislature to make sure that the final bill provides adequate resources to meet the growing needs of older Iowans and the requirements of CMS for case management services.

Call to Action

Crucial to our analysis is the belief that CMS will require that no person delivering waiver services to recipients of CMPFE may also perform the function of case management. The Iowa Department of Human services have been consistent on this point throughout many recent conversations. If we are correct in this assumption, the \$70 cap on services is too low and the total appropriation does not cover the costs of the program.

[HSB 764](#) does not include the “Winning Compliance” budget offer of \$62,500. We think that public education and information are critical for older Iowans and their families as they make choices about their long term care needs, particularly relates to assisted living, adult day services and elder group homes. We hope that resources can be found to fund this important education campaign.

The department looks forward to continuing work with the General Assembly in crafting its budget for FY 2007 that provides benefit to older Iowans, particularly those most in need or at risk or premature or unnecessary institutionalization.

What Can Be Done to Participate in the Legislative Process Related to [HSB 764](#):

The department encourages all Iowans to participate in the legislative process. If you have thoughts and opinions on what should happen with the Health and Human Services appropriations bill, especially related to CMPFE and consumer education related to assisted living, adult day services and elder group homes, ***NOW*** is the time to contact not only your own representative (available at www.legis.state.is.us) but it is also valuable to contact House Leadership in addition to the committee chairs for Appropriations and Human Resources. We are again providing this information for your convenience. Iowans can participate by calling, writing or e-mailing their legislators.

Other Issues:

Single point of Entry

On February 28th, Representative Linda Upmeyer introduced [HSB 753](#), which proposes a state wide study group to determine ways in which older Iowans, their families and caregivers can more easily access long-term living resources and to empower consumers in planning, evaluating, and making decisions to appropriately meet their individual long-term care needs. On March 2nd, the bill

passed the full standing committee and now moves to the House floor. Representative Upmeyer has stated that the bill will need some additional work and will submit an amendment on the floor.

Personal Needs Allowance

[HF 2319](#) related to the Personal Needs Allowance (PNA) passed the House on Wednesday, March 1st and now moves to the Senate. The PNA for Iowan's who use Medicaid to cover the expenses of the cost of

institutionalization has been a concern of the Older Iowan's Legislature (OIL) for a number of years. [HF 2319](#) increases the monthly PNA from \$30.00 to \$50.00. The total cost (both State and Federal Funds) is an estimated 3.3 million in FY '07.
