## Profits to State Top \$1 Billion Mark

Preliminary figures show that from the I owa Lottery's start in 1985 through theend of March, the lottery had raised morethan $\$ 1$ billion for state programs. All lottery proceeds are now sent to the state general fund. The Lottery also provides a portion of its revenues to the state Gambling Treatment Program, which administers the 1-800-BETSOFF helplinefor thoseconcerned about program gambling. Iowa Lottery products currently aresold at about 4,000 retail locations in thestateand lottery sales have provided about \$297 million in commission incometo those businesses. A recent month's sal es total s show that from its 1985 start through theend of March, the I owa Lottery has sold morethan $\$ 3.7$ billion in tickets while players have won nearly $\$ 2$ billion in prizes.
