## Defensive Driving Shifts Online - Effective September 10, 2020

As more business operations shift online during COVID-19, DAS Fleet Services will be offering web-based Defensive Driving classes by the National Safety Council (NSC) beginning Tuesday, September 8, making required training more convenient for State drivers and cost effective for State agencies.

## Effective Thursday, September 10, 2020, until further notice:

- Defensive Driving requirements per <u>Iowa Administrative Council (IAC) 11-103.12(8A) Corrective</u> <u>Actions</u> have been modified to allow Defensive Driving online in lieu of classroom training provided by the Iowa State Patrol. DAS Fleet Services will notify drivers and Agency Fleet Contacts of required Defensive Driving and provide a web link for online enrollment. Agencies will be billed \$31.95 per person for the online course via eDAS (vs \$35 for classroom instruction).
- 2) Defensive Driving pursuant to <u>IAC 11-103.8(8A) Mandatory Training</u> is waived.

This means only drivers who meet <u>Corrective Actions criteria per IAC 11-103.12(8A)</u> will be required to complete Defensive Driving, and courses will be online instead of in person.

All other requirements pursuant to IAC 11-103 (8A) remain in effect.
