## \$28,000 Grand Prize Includes Taxes Paid

Starting July 27, players only need to make the required purchase of $\$ 5$ worth of any lotto game on one ticket and the lotto terminal will print an entry form for their chance to win the HarleyDavidson prize package worth $\$ 28,000$. To win, players must return the entry form in a yellow Iowa Lottery second-chance drawing envelope.

The lottery will award one grand prize package of a 2003 Harley-Davidson Heritage Softail ${ }^{\circledR}$ Classic motorcycle and a sixitem prize package of Harley-Davidson merchandise. The grand prize also includes all required federal and state withholding taxes paid. Nine first-prize winners will receive six-item prize packages. The six-item Harley-Davidson prize package consists of: duffel bag, blanket, watch, sunglasses, leather cap and T-shirt, all with the Harley-Davidson logo.

## Players Should Use Yellow Envelopes Only

The promotion runs from July 27 through close of business on Aug. 23. Entries must be received by close of business on Aug. 26. A drawing will be held for all the prizes on Aug. 28. The lottery will accept entries only in special yellow second-chance drawing envelopes available at retailers. Only one entry is allowed per envelope and entries must be mailed in the yellow second-chance drawing envelope to be eligible. No hand-delivered entries will be accepted.

## Cedar Rapids Man Claims \$50,000 Prize

## Machine Was Out of Tickets He Wanted; Bought Others and Won Prize



J oe Hernandez of Cedar Rapids

He wasn't able to buy the lottery ticket he really wanted, and it paid off with a $\$ 50,000$ prize for a Cedar Rapids man!

Joe Hernandez said he wanted to buy a $\$ 10$ scratch ticket at the supermarket, but the vending machine was out of those, so he bought two $\$ 5$ tickets instead.

Hernandez, 70, who is retired, won the top prize of $\$ 50,000$ on one of those "Casino Action" tickets. Hernandez said he immediately went home and told his wife the good news. They have plans close to home for his winnings.
"We're going to make a big house payment!" he said.
Hernandez claimed his \$50,000 prize at the Iowa Lottery's regional office in Cedar Rapids. He bought his winning ticket at the Hy-Vee at 279 Collins Road N.E. in Cedar Rapids.

Casino Action is a $\$ 5$ scratch game with a casino-game theme. Each ticket has four play areas and prizes range from $\$ 5$ to $\$ 50,000$.

Players may visit the Iowa Lottery at 2015 Grand Ave. in Des Moines or go to one of the lottery's regional offices in Council Bluffs, Storm Lake, Mason City or Cedar Rapids to claim prizes.

## Hot Lotto Lucky for \$10,000 for Sioux City Man

A Sioux City man said he didn't know what to think at first when a supermarket clerk scanned his Hot Lotto ticket and gave him a receipt instructing him to claim a prize at an Iowa Lottery office.
"The manager came over and he said, 'Well, it looks like you're going on a drive,'" Greg Newell said. "He said, 'How does \$10,000 sound to you?' And I said, 'Well, it sounds outstanding!'"

Newell claimed a $\$ 10,000$ Hot Lotto prize at the lottery's regional office in Council Bluffs. He bought his winning ticket at Hy-Vee at 313 Cook St. in Sioux City.

Newell came close to winning it all, matching the first five numbers and missing only the Hot Ball. He said the numbers he plays are a combination of his children and grandchildren's birthdays.

Newell, 55, who drives a cement truck, said he plans to pay bills with his winnings.

There's a difference between the expiration dates of lotto tickets sold for Iowa-only games and those for multi-state games.

Iowa games' tickets expire 90 days after the drawing for which they are eligible ( $\$ 100,000$ Cash Game, Pick 3 and Freeplay Replay).

Multi-state games' tickets are good for 365 days after the drawing for which they are eligible (Powerball and Hot Lotto).
