HERE'S HELP TO PAY FOR A PRIVATE COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY!

The need-based Iowa Tuition Grant was created in 1969 to make education at private colleges and universities more affordable for Iowans. In 2018-19, 10,540 Iowans received almost \$47 million. File the FAFSA to find out if you qualify!

FOR IOWANS WHO ...

- Are enrolled as undergraduates at an eligible Iowa private college or university (see categories below).
- File the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) by July 1.
- Have financial need, as determined by the FAFSA.

NOT-FOR-PROFIT SCHOOLS

Iowa students who qualify for the Iowa Tuition Grant can use it at any of 29 private not-for-profit colleges and universities in the state. In 2018-19, the average award per student was \$4,600.

FOR-PROFIT SCHOOLS

The Iowa Tuition Grant can also be used at accredited for-profit colleges and universities in Iowa. In 2018-19, the average award per student was \$1,785.

BARBER & COSMETOLOGY SCHOOLS

Barber and Cosmetology students in Iowa can also qualify for the Iowa Tuition Grant. In 2018-19, the average award per student was \$225.
