If all other available state and federal financial aid falls short, the Future Ready Iowa Last-Dollar Scholarship is here to fill the gap. The scholarship launched in 2019-20, and 6.460 Iowans received more than \$12.6 million.

- Plan to earn a certificate, diploma, or associate's degree aligned with a designated high-demand job.
- File the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) by August 1.
- · Have applied for and used all other available aid.

ELIGIBLE SCHOOLS

You can use the Last-Dollar Scholarship at community colleges or accredited private colleges in Iowa that offer eligible programs of study and provide required student services.

ELIGIBLE PROGRAMS

The list of programs is based on job demand and might change from year to year. If your program is removed, you will still be eligible until you complete your credential, as long as you meet all other criteria.

REQUIREMENTS FOR RECIPIENTS

You must attend orientation, meet with an advisor, remain continuously enrolled, and make satisfactory academic progress.

OTHER BENEFITS

Recipients are also eligible for texting and mentoring support to ensure their college success.
