## **COVID-19: Governor's Proclamation** Makes it Easier for Some to Return to **Work After Retirement**

Governor Reynolds issued a Public Health Emergency Proclamation that makes it easier for members who retired from IPERS-covered employment to more readily return to work.

The proclamation applies to:

- Retired members who return to IPERS-covered employment as a teacher or substitute teacher.
- Licensed health care professionals who were previously employed by a hospital licensed pursuant to chapter 135B, any state or local government public health employee, any "protection occupation" employee as defined by Iowa Code § 97B.49B(1)(e), a member of the board of parole, or any sheriff or deputy sheriff as defined by Iowa Code § 97B.49C(1)(b) or (c).

The proclamation waives the time period required before retirees can return to IPERS-covered employment and removes the limitation on annual earnings during the period the proclamation is in effect.

Retirees who are younger than age 70 can return to IPERS-covered employment after the retiree receives one benefit payment. This means retirees are no longer subject to the bona fide retirement period that mandates that retirees cannot return to work for an IPERS-covered employer until the retiree has received at least four monthly benefit payments.

Retirees who are younger than age 65 are no longer required to pay back a portion of their IPERS benefit if they earn more than \$30,000 annually.

The proclamation is effective until 11:59 p.m. on Monday, December 10, 2020. For more information, reference sections 18 and 139 in the full proclamation **here**.
