

EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 45

- WHEREAS, the natural resources of our state require careful and coordinated management to maintain their values for this and future generations of Iowans;
- WHEREAS, various state agencies have responsibilities for management of our natural resources; and
- WHEREAS, a forum should exist for all such state agencies to meet and coordinate actions; and
- WHEREAS, Senate File 2218, passed by the Second Session of the 69th General Assembly and signed into law gives responsibility to a state interagency resource council to assist in implementing this land use law,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert D. Ray, Governor of the State of Iowa, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws and Constitution of the State of Iowa do hereby establish the

INTERAGENCY RESOURCE COUNCIL

whose members will be the following or their designee:

- The Secretary of Agriculture
- The Executive Director of the Department of Water, Air, and Waste Management
- The Director of the Conservation Commission
- The Director of the Department of Soil Conservation
- The Director of the Department of Transportation
- The Director of the Development Commission
- The State Archeologist
- The State Geologist
- The Director of the Office for Planning and Programming
- The Director of the Energy Policy Council
- The Director of the Natural Resources Council until June 30, 1983.

Said Interagency Resources Council shall forthwith proceed to:

1. Carry out its responsibilities under Senate File 2218, Acts of the Second Session of the 69th General Assembly.
2. Meet as needed to coordinate actions of the state agencies to more effectively manage the state's natural resources.
3. Annually elect a chair from among its members.
