Pop YS Live!: Accessible Youth Programming

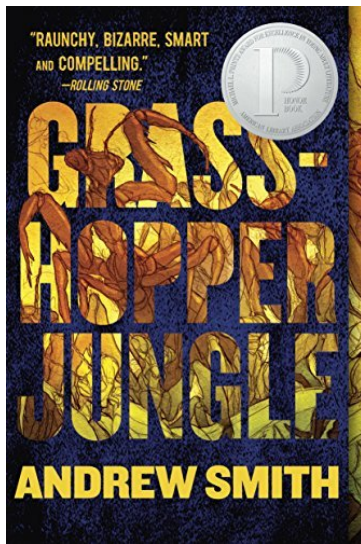
Thursday, November 18, 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.
