At A Glance...

Ask First if it's a Credit Card or a Debit Card

Remember that there's a big difference between a debit card and a credit card—even though they may look the same. Many banks offer their customers debit cards that can be used to withdraw money from their checking or savings account. Plus, some cards are combination credit cards and debit cards.

If a lottery player hands you a card, it's important to ask the player which kind of card they have before you make the transaction. Lottery players can use debit cards to purchase lottery products. However, state law prohibits the use of credit cards to make a lottery purchase. Avoid inconveniencing your customers by checking carefully any card presented to you. 🍀

Van Zante, 33, a technology consultant, won the grand prize bowl trip in the Iowa Lottery's Hawkeye Football Promotion in November. Players entered the promotion with a nonwinning "Red Hot 7s" scratch ticket. The trip, valued at \$10,000, included airfare, a four-night hotel stay at the InterContinental Hotel in Miami, spending money and withholding taxes paid. He took his wife Karla on the trip with him. They live in Des Moines.

Although the trip's theme was the Orange Bowl game, the Van Zantes were able to do a lot of sightseeing and relaxing on the trip as well. They attended a welcoming party after they arrived in Miami on Dec. 30, and they were able to spend the next two days shopping, walking on the beach and cruising the local waterways. Van Zante said they went on a casino cruise past Miami Beach and South Beach, where he won some money.

"I've had a good lucky streak," he said, laughing.

On New Year's Eve the Van Zantes attended a party and dance in the hotel's grand ballroom where they had a nice meal and enjoyed the atmosphere.

He said he enjoyed meeting people from all over the country who came to see the game. Some were taken by surprise when Iowa was invited to the Orange Bowl. Many had expected they might be invited to the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, Calif. Van Zante attended Iowa State University and his wife got her master's degree from the University of Iowa, so they have some loyalty to both teams.

"Iowa brings fans everywhere. Three-fourths of that stadium were Iowa fans," he said. "They do have a big loyal following. I talked to people from all over the nation that came down and a lot of them said if they (Iowa) were going to the Rose Bowl, they probably wouldn't have come because they had been to the Rose Bowl in 1991."

Van Zante said the trip was "wonderful" and said visiting South Beach was his favorite part of the trip. 🎯
