To His Excellency, B. F. Carroll, Governor of the State of Iowa:

SIR:—Complying with the law, as provided in Section 150, Chapter 8 of the Code, as amended by Chapter 6, Laws of the Thirty-third General Assembly, I have the honor to submit herewith the report of this office containing a statement of all the expenditures of this office from January 1, 1909, to September 30, 1910, inclusive.

The total expense incurred for the twenty-one months, for all purposes, coming properly under the jurisdiction of the custodian, has been \$49,124.01.

“A” is a classified and itemized statement of all expenditures during the period mentioned.

“B” is a statement of all sales made of State property and the money paid to the Treasurer of State.

“C” is an invoice of tools and materials charged to this office.

“D” is an invoice of furniture.

I would also report that, in my opinion, there should be steps taken to render the basement walls of the Historical Building water-proof.

Dampness penetrates the wall, below the grade line, so much that the plastering is peeling off, and furniture placed near the wall is being damaged. A heavy coat of cement mortar, on the outside of the wall, and this cement covered with a coat of asphaltum would remedy the defect.

The next General Assembly should be asked to provide more office rooms for the accommodation of the different Boards that are now located in nine of the committee rooms.

The air compressor in the engine room is not of sufficient capacity; it should be replaced by one of about double the present capacity.

A part of our steam-heating system is automatic and a part of it is direct. This causes much trouble, for the part that is direct

requires frequent attention to keep the room at an even temperature, prevent a waste of steam, and water on the floor.

I recommend that a five-foot cement walk be laid from the north steps to the northeast corner of the grounds, to accommodate the general public in passing between the Historical Building and the Capitol; it would also prevent the making of paths on the lawn.

I would renew the recommendation of my predecessor, that an appropriation of \$15,000 be made, to cover the cost of replacing the north and west steps with granite, repairing interior walks, changing the heating system, air compressor and damp-proofing the Historical Building.

In my opinion, there should be a janitress in the Historical Building, and at least one of the janitors there should be under the control of the custodian.

I recommend that the closets in the men's toilet room in the basement be taken out and that modern, sanitary closets be installed. The cost of keeping these old closets in repair will soon pay the cost of new closets.

My thanks are due to you and to each member of the Executive Council for kind assistance and co-operation in all my efforts to care for the property of the State.
